## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS I have been satisfied that there exists among the Cattle in the Island of Java, a contagious and infectious disease known as Rinderpest; Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, in exercise of the powers in me vested, and in particular by the Cattle Diseases Ordinance, 1865, do by this Proclamation, with the advice of the Executive Council, prohibit the Importation into and landing of Cattle in Western Australia, from the said Island of Java, and from all adjoining countries or places, until further order or direction in that behalf.
