WHEREAS by my Proclamation dated Government House, the 21st day of November, 1881, I, the said Governor, did notify and proclaim the Port of Perth as a Warehousing Port under "The Customs Ordinance, 1860," and whereas the said Port is no longer required for such purpose; NOW THEREFORE I, the said Governor, do hereby notify that the said recited Proclamation is hereby repealed.
