**FINDING OF THE COURT.***Read to Captain Patching in open Court.*

Having carefully considered the foregoing evidence, we are of opinion that the wreck of the barque "Agincourt" was owing to the default of the Master, Henry Patching.

1st.—By neglecting to sight his anchor from the time of his arrival at Hamelin, on the 17th February, to the 19th April (two months), being in an open roadstead and knowing the bottom to consist of rock with intervening patches of sand and surrounded by reefs on every side.

2nd.—By allowing the said vessel to drag into a position of danger before taking the necessary precautions to ensure her safety.

We therefore adjudge that the certificate of service No. 119, of the said Henry Patching, be suspended for the space of six months from this date, subject to the approval of His Excellency the Governor.

**H**IS Excellency the Governor directs it to be notified, for general information, that a despatch has been received from the Government of India, stating that Waler horses for Army purposes will be purchased during the year 1882-83, to the number and conditions, as follows:—

At Madras ... .. One hundred,  
" Calcutta ... .. Seventy-five.

Except under special circumstances, purchases will be made only between the 15th September and 28th February.

Horses and mares of all breeds will be received, but they must be within the prescribed age, 4 to 7 years, except as regards country breeds. It is to be distinctly understood that in regard to classes I and III remounts three years old and mares in foal will not be purchased.

After the expiration of three (3) years from the 21st June, 1879, greys will not be purchased for Horse or Field Artillery.

The average price for a remount has been fixed at Rupees five hundred and fifty (Rs. 550). Every horse presented for purchase will be valued separately, and higher or lower prices may be given, provided that the average of the purchases does not exceed that limit.
