WHEREAS the Legislative Council now stands prorogued until Wednesday, the twenty-third day of May next; And whereas it is desirable that the same should sooner meet; Now THEREFORE I, HENRY THOMAS WRENFORDSLEY, being Administrator of the Government of the said Colony, in exercise of the powers in me vested, do hereby announce and proclaim that a SESSION OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA shall be holden, for the DESPATCH OF BUSINESS, on FRIDAY, the THIRTEENTH day of APRIL next ensuing, at THREE o'clock in the AFTERNOON, in the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, in the CITY OF PERTH, within the said Colony; and the MEMBERS of the Legislative Council are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that His Excellency the Administrator has been pleased to establish and fix the following as the boundaries or limits of the undermentioned Magisterial Districts:—

KIMBERLEY DISTRICT.

So much of the Colony as lies to the North of the parallel of 19° 30' South Latitude.

NORTHERN DISTRICT.

Bounded on the *North* by the Kimberley District. On the *West* by the sea coast, including the islands adjacent to it. On the *South* by a line from the southernmost point of Exmouth Gulf direct to Mount Palgrave, thence due East to the boundary of the Colony; and on the *East* by the said boundary of the Colony.

GASCOYNE DISTRICT.

Bounded on the *North* by the Northern District. On the *West* by the Sea Coast, including the islands adjacent to it. On the *South* by a due East line from the coast, passing through the summit of Mt. Murchison to the boundary of the Colony; and on the *East* by the said boundary of the Colony.

VICTORIA DISTRICT.

Bounded on the *North* by the Gascoyne District. On the *West* by the Sea Coast, including the islands adjacent to it. On the *South* by a line starting from the Sea Coast North of Long Island and extending due East, passing through a spot 20 miles North from Dandaraga Spring till it meets a due North line from the summit of Wongan Hills, and from the said summit by a due East line to the East boundary of the Colony; and on the *East* by the said boundary of the Colony.

NOTE.—Notice No. 1115, C.S.O., of the 15th February, 1882, defining the boundaries of the Victoria Magisterial District, is hereby cancelled.

Special Occupation Licenses.*Crown Lands' Office,
Perth, 9th March, 1883.*

SPECIAL Occupation Licenses under the Land Regulations prior to the 11th October, 1882, were granted for *three years*, at the expiration of which time if the licensee is not prepared to purchase the land under No. 4 of the conditions mentioned in the body of his license, a *lease* should be applied for, and is granted for a term of seven years.

As all licenses granted before July, 1880, have therefore now expired, the licensees who have not already done so are requested to apply for leases *as soon as possible* if they wish to retain their lands.

Forms of application can be procured at the Crown Lands' Office, Perth, or at the offices of the various Government Residents and Resident Magistrates throughout the Colony.

THE attention of Lessees and Licensees of land under Special Occupation is called to the 5th Section of Clause 56 of the Land Regulations, which runs as follows:—

“If the aforesaid improvements have not been made before the end of the (lease or) license, the (lessee or) licensee or his representatives may continue to hold the land at the same annual rental, but no Crown Grant will be issued until the improvements have been duly made.” Application for Crown Grant must be accompanied with a satisfactory certificate that the necessary conditions have been complied with.
