Commissioner of Crown Lands.

1. The land to be reserved exclusively as a pasture for those cattle and horses which are the *bona fide* home-stock of resident occupiers, either their own property or the stock belonging to their tenancy.

2. Resident occupiers to mean all residing within a radius of five miles from the centre of a line drawn through the extreme inland angles of Rockingham Townsite.

3. The term home-stock to mean the usual stock and increase attaching to each occupancy.

4. Inasmuch as it is a necessary custom to vary the feed by sending stock to the hills, and taking stock from the hills in exchange, all such *bona fide* exchange to be regarded the same as if the stock of residents; provided they be kept within the limits of a fair equivalent, *i.e.*, not exceeding ten head difference.

5. Pasturing of Sheep or Goats strictly prohibited.

6. All stock found on the land contrary to the foregoing stipulations will be treated as trespassing, and dealt with according to law.
