TORRES STRAIT—GREAT NORTH-EAST CHANNEL.

SHOAL SOUTH-WEST OF NINEPIN ROCK.

The French Government has given Notice—on the authority of the Commander of the French vessel Vétéran—of the existence of a shoal lying about 3 miles south-westward of Ninepin rock, in the course recommended through the Great North-east channel to Torres

This shoal (*Veteran shoal*) is stated to extend in the shape of a crescent (concave side to the north-west) for a distance of about one cable in a north-east and south-west direction, with a breadth of about a quarter of a cable, and judging from the color of the water, the depth was estimated to be about 2½ fathoms; it lies with the following approximate bearings:—

Ninepin rock Burke island summit ... N.E. N.W. ‡ W.
