This Bill passed the second reading at the late Session of the Federal Council of Australasia, and is intended to be proceeded with unless reasons to the contrary should appear.

A BILL to declare the Status of Corporations and Joint Stock Companies in Colonies other than the Colony in which they have been constituted, and for other purposes.

Preamble.

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the status of Corporations and Joint Stock Companies constituted according to the laws of the several Australasian Colonies in other Colonies than the Colony in which they are respectively constituted, and it is expedient to remove such doubts, and to declare and define the status and the rights, powers, capacities, and privileges of such Corporations and Joint Stock Companies: Be it therefore enacted and declared by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Federal Council of Australasia, assembled at Hobart, in the Colony of Tasmania, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. THIS Act may be cited as "The Australasian Corporations Act, 1886."

Interpretation.

2. IN this Act—

"Colony of Incorporation" means the Colony under the laws of which the Corporation in question is constituted:

"Colony of Registration" means the Colony in which the Corporation in question is registered under the provisions of this Act:

"Corporation" includes any joint stock company or other company or society which under the laws of the Colony of Incorporation has perpetual succession and a common seal:

"Supreme Court" means the Court having unlimited civil jurisdiction in the Colony in question.

Registration of Corporations.

3. ANY Corporation duly constituted under the laws of any Colony in which this Act is in force may procure itself to be registered in any other Colony in which this Act is in force, in the manner hereinafter prescribed.

Certificate of incorporation and other documents to be de-

4. A CORPORATION desiring to be so registered shall cause to be lodged in the office of the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies of the Colony in which it desires to be registered, or if there is no

such officer then in the office of the Supreme Court of that Colony, a certificate of incorporation under the hand of the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies or other proper officer of the Colony of Incorporation, and under the seal of his office, together with a copy, certified by such registrar or other officer, of the memorandum and articles of association, deed of settlement, Act, Ordinance, or other instrument declaring the constitution and functions of the Corporation.

posited in office of Registrar of Joint Stock Companies.

5. THE Governor of any Colony in which this Act is in force, with the advice of his Executive Council, may prescribe what fees shall be payable upon the registration of a Corporation in such Colony under this Act, but such fees shall not exceed the fees payable upon the registration of a Corporation of like constitution under the laws of that Colony.

Fee on registration.

6. UPON the lodging of such certificate and other document or documents as hereinbefore prescribed, and upon payment of the prescribed fee, the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies, or Registrar of the Supreme Court, or other proper officer with whom they are so lodged, shall issue a Certificate under his hand and the seal of his office in the form following or to the like effect:—

Certificate of registration to be issued.

I, Registrar of Joint Stock Companies [*or as the case may be*] of the Colony of hereby certify that the [*name of Corporation*] duly incorporated on [*date of incorporation*] under the laws of the Colony of has this day been registered in the office of the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies [*or as the case may be*] of the Colony of in in accordance with the provisions of "The Australasian Corporations Act, 1886."

Given under my hand and seal of office at this day of 18 .

7. A COPY of such Certificate shall be published in the *Government Gazette* or other official *Gazette* of the Government of the Colony of Registration.

Certificate to be published in *Government Gazette*.

8. UPON such registration and publication being made, the Corporation named in the Certificate shall, within the Colony of Registration, have and be entitled to the same rights, powers, capacities, and privileges, and be subject to the same obligations, liabilities, and disabilities, as if it had been incorporated under the laws of the Colony of Registration. Provided that no such Corporation shall be entitled to take, hold, convey, or transfer land in the Colony of Registration, if by the laws of the Colony of Incorporation it is not entitled so to do in that Colony, or to any greater extent than it is entitled so to do in that Colony, or except under and subject to such conditions (if any) as are imposed by the laws of the Colony of Incorporation and by the constitution of the Corporation.

Effect of registration and publication of certificate.

9. WITHIN any Colony in which this Act is in force, a Corporation constituted under the laws of another Australasian Colony, whether this Act is in force therein or not, is not competent to take, hold, convey, or transfer land, unless such Corporation has been registered in the first-mentioned Colony in accordance with the provisions of this Act, or unless some Act or Ordinance has been passed by the Legislature of that Colony empowering such Corporation to take, hold, convey, or transfer land in that Colony.

Disabilities of Corporations not registered.

Proof of Registration.

10. PRODUCTION of the *Government Gazette* or other official *Gazette* of the Government of the Colony of Registration, purporting to contain a copy of a Certificate issued under the provisions of this Act, shall be *prima facie* evidence for the purpose of proceedings in any Court of Justice, or for any other purpose, of the due registration in that Colony of the Corporation mentioned in such Certificate.

Power to liquidators to deal with land in Colony of Registration.

11. IN the event of the winding-up of a Corporation registered in any Colony under the provisions of this Act, the liquidators or other persons duly appointed according to the laws of the Colony of Incorporation to wind up its affairs and distribute its assets shall have full power and authority to convey, transfer, or otherwise deal with any land held by such Corporation in the Colony of Registration.

Proof of appointment of liquidators.

12. A CERTIFICATE purporting to be signed by the Registrar of the Supreme Court of the Colony of Incorporation, and to be under the seal of his office, stating the fact of the appointment of any such liquidators or other persons, shall be *prima facie* evidence of their due appointment.

Commencement.

13. THIS Act shall commence and take effect on the first day of _____, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-_____.

A BILL to alter the law relating to the procedure under "The Designs and Trade Marks Act, 1884," and "An Act to regulate grants of Patents for Inventions in the Colony of Western Australia."

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Patent Office.

1. THERE shall be provided for the purposes of "The Designs and Trade Marks Act, 1884," and the Act intituled "An Act to regulate grants of Patents for Inventions in the Colony of Western Australia," an Office with all requisite conveniences, which shall be called the Patent Office.

Registrar.

2. THE Patent Office shall be under the immediate control of an Officer called the Registrar of Patents, Designs, and Trade Marks.

Duties in absence of Registrar.

3. ANY act or thing directed to be done by or to the Registrar may in his absence be done by or to any officer for the time being in that behalf authorised by the Governor.

4. THERE shall be a Seal for the Patent Office, and impressions thereof shall be judicially noticed and admitted in evidence. Patent Office Seal.

5. ALL the powers, duties, privileges, and rights conferred upon or to be done or exercised by the Colonial Secretary, and all acts or things directed to be done by or to the Colonial Secretary under the provisions of either of the Acts aforesaid, or any general rules made under the provisions of "The Designs and Trade Marks Act, 1884," shall be conferred upon and done or exercised by or to the Registrar of Patents, Designs, and Trade Marks; and all applications, notices, documents, matters, and things required by either of the Acts or rules aforesaid to be furnished, given, or sent to or left or deposited at the office of the Colonial Secretary, shall be furnished, given, or sent to or left or deposited at the Patent Office. Powers and duties of Colonial Secretary transferred.

Substitution of Patent Office for Office of Colonial Secretary.

6. THE words "Colonial Secretary" and "Colonial Secretary's Office," wherever they may occur in either of the aforesaid Acts, or in any general rules made under the provisions of "The Designs and Trade Marks Act, 1884," shall be respectively read "Registrar of Patents, Designs, and Trade Marks" and "Patent Office." Reading of words in 36 V. 1 and 48 V. 7.

7. ALL instruments, records, certified copies, matters, documents, and things required under the provisions of either of the Acts aforesaid or of any general rules as aforesaid shall be sealed with the seal of the Patent Office and not with the Public Seal of the Colony, except in the case of Letters Patent and Letters of Registration of a Patent which shall be sealed in each case with both seals. Seal of Patent Office to be used.

8. THIS Act shall be read and construed together with "The Designs and Trade Marks Act, 1884," as one Act. To be read with 48 V. 7 as one Act.

9. THIS Act shall be read and construed together with an Act intituled "An Act to regulate grants of Patents for Inventions in the Colony of Western Australia," as one Act. To be read with 36 V. 1 as one Act.

A BILL to impose a Duty upon the Importation of Opium.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. ON and after the passing of this Act, there shall be charged, raised, collected, levied, and paid upon opium, and all goods, wares, and merchandise mixed or saturated with opium or with any preparation or solution thereof, or steeped therein respectively, imported into Western Australia, whether by land or by sea, in lieu of any duty now imposed thereon, a specific duty of Twenty shillings per lb. Duty on Opium.

2. THE said duty shall be collected and levied in the manner provided by and subject and according to the provisions of any Ordinance, Act, or law for the time being in force for the general regulation of the Customs of the Colony. Collection of duty.

3. THIS Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Opium Duty Act, 1886." Short Title.
