## PROCLAMATION

Western Australia, } By His Excellency Sir FREDERICK

F. NAPIER BROOME, in-Chief in and over the Territory of  
Governor. Western Australia and its Depend-  
encies, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS I have been satisfied that there exists amongst the cattle from the Straits Settlements and the Dutch Islands a contagious and infectious disease known as "Foot and Mouth Disease"; Now THEREFORE I, the said Governor, in exercise of the powers in me vested, and in particular by "The Cattle Diseases Ordinance, 1865," do by this Proclamation, with the advice of the Executive Council, prohibit the Importation into and landing of Cattle in Western Australia from the said Straits Settlements and the Dutch Islands, and from all adjoining countries and places, until further order or direction in that behalf.

Given under my hand and under the Public Seal of the said Colony, at Government House, Perth, this thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six.

# PUBLIC FUNERAL

OF THE LATE

SIR L. S. LEAKE, KNIGHT,

*Speaker of the Legislative Council,*

ON TUESDAY, JULY 6th, 1886.

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WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR has been pleased to direct that the remains of the late SIR LUKE SAMUEL LEAKE, KNIGHT, should, as a mark of the estimation in which he was held by his brother Colonists of all grades, and in recognition of his services as Speaker of the Legislative Council during a period of sixteen years, receive the honor of a Public Funeral.

The remains of the deceased gentleman will be removed from his residence in St. George's Terrace, at 2:30 p.m., the 6th instant, and be met at the Cathedral Gates by the Public Officers and others taking part in the procession.

The Metropolitan Rifle Volunteers will form a lane for the Hearse to pass through, from the Cathedral Gate nearest the Public Offices, to the Cathedral Door, and will afterwards form in Sections in St. George's Terrace, opposite the Deanery. When the Body leaves the Cathedral, the Hearse will be halted in rear of the Metropolitan Volunteers, to allow time for the formation of the Procession; as soon as the Procession is formed it will move off, the Band playing the Dead March.

Captain Phillips, Acting Commandant of the Volunteers and Acting Superintendent of Police, will have entire control of all the arrangements connected with the procession and ceremony.

The seats in the nave of the Cathedral will be reserved for those taking part in the procession. The general public will be admitted to the remainder of the Cathedral, and are requested to take their seats by 2:15 p.m., punctually, as there will be no admission to the Cathedral after that hour.

The Procession in the foregoing order will move off from the Cathedral by way of St. George's Terrace, Adelaide Terrace, Bennett Street, and Cemetery Road.

On arriving in front of the Cemetery, the Mounted Escort will form across the road, on the further side of the gate.

The Metropolitan Volunteers, on reaching the top of Cemetery Hill, will open out their ranks to right and left, halt and face inwards, forming a lane for the Body to pass through, the rear rank with their backs to the Cemetery fence, and the front rank on the opposite side of the road. After it has passed, they will rejoin the procession.

St. George's Terrace and Adelaide Terrace, between Barrack Street and Bennett Street, will be closed for traffic from 2.15 p.m. until the Funeral Procession has reached the Cemetery.
