HIS Excellency the Governor directs it to be notified, for general information, that a free pardon will be given to any person being an accomplice concerned in the murder of Messrs. Anketell and Burrup (provided such person be not the actual murderer) who shall give information which will lead to the conviction of the murderer or murderers, or any person or persons concerned in or connected with the perpetration of the deed.

The pardon shall extend only to the first person who shall give such information.
