SUNKEN REEF AND BUOY OFF EMU POINT.

**N**OTICE is hereby given, that a Sunken Reef of Rocks, not shown on the chart, and on which the depth of water does not exceed 3 feet at low-water springs, extends N.N.E. 2½ cables from the Eastern extreme of Emu Point.

A Black Buoy has been placed off the end of the reef, in 16 feet at low water.

To clear the reef, Round Rock should not be closed in with Entrance Rock, until the southern extreme of Flumpy Island is opened northward of Pelican Island, when vessels may haul to the westward, and pick up an anchorage according to their draught of water.

HALIFAX BAY.

POSITIONS OF PHILLIPS ROCK, LORNE REEF, AND  
PALUMA SHOALS.

**N**OTICE is hereby given, that Phillips Rock lies S. 55° W. 1½ miles from the eastern summit of Acheron Island, and has on it a depth of 6 feet at low-water springs. The Rock is of small extent and

has 8 fathoms close to. The shoal ground marked on the chart as extending from it, does not exist.

LORNE REEF consists of two small rocky patches, the westernmost, which dries 1 foot at low-water springs, bearing from the summit of Rattlesnake Island S. 75° W., distant 1½ miles. The easternmost patch with less than 6 feet upon it lying E. ¼ S. from the former, distant one-sixth of a mile.

PALUMA SHOALS—the outermost of which bears from Rattlesnake Island summit, S. 38° W., distant 5 miles—consist of a chain of sand and coral patches extending in an easterly and southerly direction to the Coast.

The foregoing information has been obtained by Lieutenant G. E. Richards, R.N., Commanding H.M. Surveying Vessel "Paluma."

The shores of Halifax Bay, not having yet been thoroughly examined, vessels are recommended not to approach them within 3 miles.

PRELIMINARY HYDROGRAPHIC NOTICE.

THE dangers reported off Komarie Point, and on which the s.s. "Graville" and "Magregor" are said to have struck, do not exist in the positions assigned.

A careful examination of the locality has been made by Captain Aldrich and the Officers of H.M.S. "Egeria," and as a result, the coast should not be approached nearer than 20 fathoms in thick weather between Komarie and Batticaloa.

The ridge shown on the present Admiralty Sheet and in the neighborhood of Komarie is about 2 miles North of its proper position, which latter is as follows:—

Its North extreme is in about 7° 2' 30" N., and 1¼ mile from the shore.

The South extreme is in about 6° 59' N., and 0·8 mile from the shore.

It is narrow, and composed of sand and coral patches. On several of the latter there is as little as 2½ fathoms of water. The whole forms a dangerous reef.

Outside it, and to a distance of 4 miles from the shore, the ground is very uneven, and a patch with 7 fathoms on it lies 3·7 miles from the nearest shore, and from it Agunis Peak bears N. 69 W. (true).

The effects of the winds and currents hereabouts, as also on the edge of the Bank of Soundings, are seen in heavy overfalls and tide rips, which may be mistaken for shoal water,—sometimes being met with even in the finest weather.

The closely approximate position of the Alphee shoal is in Lat. 7° 26' N. Long., 81° 51' 30" E. coral; least water, 3½ fathoms.

Komarie Point is a rounded curve in the coast line, and cannot be distinguished as a point from the sea, unless very close into the shore.

The appearance of the coast changes at times very rapidly, and estimated distances were often found much in error during the survey. This notice only applies to the coast between Little Basses on the South and Batticaloa on the North.
