PROCLAMATION

Western Australia, }

By His Excellency Sir FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Imperial Legislature, it is made lawful for the Governor of Western Australia, for the time being, to fix such place within any part of the said Colony, and such time for holding every Session of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, as he may think fit, and also to prorogue the said Council from time to time by proclamation or otherwise whenever he shall deem it expedient; NOW THEREFORE I, SIR FREDERICK NAPIER BROOME, K.C.M.G., being Governor as aforesaid, in exercise of the powers so in me vested, deeming it expedient to prorogue the Legislative Council of Western Australia, do hereby announce and proclaim that the said Legislative Council is prorogued accordingly to THURSDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF DECEMBER NEXT, at NOON, then to meet in the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, in the CITY OF PERTH, for the despatch of business; and the Members of the Legislative Council are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said Colony, at Government House, Perth, this twentieth day of August, 1887.
