Surveys made by such Licensed Surveyors shall, on verification and approval by the Surveyor General, be accepted by the Survey Department of the Government, and adopted in all questions between the Government and the occupiers of any demised waste lands of the Crown, and between the occupiers of any such demised land, as correct surveys.

2. In order that a survey may be examined and verified, it is necessary that the original Field Notes, accompanied by a diagram or plan, shall in every case be forwarded to this Office; and unless this is done, a survey cannot be recognised by the Government, or be recorded as a legal survey under the above Act.
