WHEREAS by the third Section of "The Customs Ordinance, 1860" (24 Victoriae, No. 5), after declaring the limits of certain Ports of the said Colony, it is provided amongst other things that it shall be lawful for the Governor to alter or vary the limits and boundaries of any of the said Ports, and to establish any new Port or Ports as to him may seem meet, by Proclamation to be published in the *Government Gazette*: Now THEREFORE I, the said Administrator, do hereby proclaim all that piece of water embraced within a radius of three-quarters of a mile from the present Dongara Lighthouse, to be a Port of the said Colony.
