Amendment of the Goldfields Regulations.

Clause 103.

Mines Department,

Perth, 2nd April, 1898.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, under the powers conferred upon him by Section 99 of "The Goldfields Act, 1895," has been pleased to cancel the amendment of Clause 103 of the Goldfields Regulations, gazetted on the 29th January, 1898, and to substitute the following in lieu thereof:—

After the end of Clause 103 to insert the following words:—Provided further, that any Miner searching for and obtaining alluvial gold, as aforesaid, must do so without undue interference with the *bonâ fide* operations and workings of the lessee, or with the buildings or shafts reasonably required by him, and any dispute or difference shall be determined by the Warden.
