WHEREAS by Section 12 (7) of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906," the Governor is empowered to alter the boundaries of the wards existing in any municipal district: And whereas a petition has been presented to His Excellency the Governor, signed with the common seal of the Municipality of North Perth, praying for the alteration of the boundaries of the East and Central Wards of the said Municipality: And whereas the said petition was publicly advertised in the *Government Gazette* on the 26th day of March, 1909: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, in pursuance of the powers so vested in him by the said Act, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby alter the boundaries of the East and Central Wards of the Municipality of North Perth, and declare them to be as follows:—

East Ward.—Bounded by lines starting from the intersection of the centre of Vincent Street with the centre of Fitzgerald Street, and extending North along the centre of Fitzgerald Street to the intersection of the centre of Fitzgerald Street and York Road, and along said centre of York Road to its intersection with the centre of Walcott Street; thence South-Eastward along said centre of Walcott Street to a point situate 12 feet 6 inches South-Eastward from its intersection with the prolongation North-Eastward of the Western side of Beaufort Street; thence South-Westward and parallel to and at a distance of 12 feet South-Eastward from said Western side of Beaufort Street to the centre of Vincent Street; thence West along said centre of Vincent Street to the starting point.
