Applicants who are officers of the Public Service of a State should state the date of their appointment to the service, present position, and salary.

Applicants from outside the service should state their qualifications for the office they seek. Copies only of diplomas, references, testimonials, or certificates should be forwarded. If the originals are required they will be asked for.

Date and year of birth should be stated, and applications must be in applicants' hand-writing. Applications should be addressed to the "Commonwealth Public Service Inspector" of the State in which the vacancy exists, and in the case of officers of the Commonwealth Service be forwarded through the chief officer of the department to which the applicant belongs.

ROEBOURNE COMMON.

Bu-laws.

Department of Lands and Surveys, Perth, 20th April, 1917.

HIS Excellency the Governor has been pleased to approve of the following By-laws made by the Roebourne Road Board for the management of the Common (Reserve 611):-

1. Each ratepayer shall be allowed to run on the Roebourne Common five head of horses and cattle respectively, at the following agistment fees:

Horses and cattle ten shillings per head per annum, or at the rate of seven and sixpence per half-year, or five shillings per quarter or any part of a quarter.

The fee per head (horses or cattle) over five in number will be one pound per head per annum.

2. No ratepayer will be allowed to run on the common more than eight horses and eight head of cattle at the same time.

3. The charge to local butchers for depasturing sheep will be ninepence per head per annum, and for depas-turing cattle seven shillings and sixpence per head per annum.

These lights will be two feet apart, and will be shown from the top of the drilling attachment or approximately 40ft. above water level.

In respect to the floating drilling punt or barge, this barge is drawn to the edge of the channel each night, and its position will be denoted by white lights as heretofore.
