WHEREAS by "The Stock Diseases Act, 1895," the Governor is empowered by Order in Council to be published in the *Government Gazette*, from time to time to make, vary, alter, or revoke such Regulations under the

said Act as may be deemed necessary for any of the purposes mentioned in the said Act: And whereas it is deemed necessary to alter the Regulations made under the said Act and published in the *Government Gazette* of the 21st day of March, 1919, by revoking the regulation numbered 2 thereof, and Schedule 5a thereto, and by substituting a new regulation and schedule in lieu thereof: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him as aforesaid, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby revokes the said regulation and schedule, and makes the following new regulation and schedule in lieu thereof:—

2. No owner, occupier, or person in charge of any holding in that portion of the State South of the 28th parallel of South Latitude shall remove or cause or permit to be removed from such holding any stud sheep, unless such sheep have been dipped within six months immediately preceding their removal. Every such owner, occupier, or person in charge shall before the removal of any stud sheep make a statutory declaration, according to Form I. in Schedule 5a hereto, that such sheep are free from tick and lice. If such sheep are found to be suffering from tick or lice, such owner, occupier, or person in charge shall cause them before removal to be dipped in a swim bath prepared with some specific known to be fatal to tick and lice, and shall make a declaration according to Form II. in Schedule 5a hereto that they have been so dipped.

REGULATIONS FOR THE GRANTING OF TOWN AND SUBURBAN LOTS IN FEE SIMPLE TO DISCHARGED SOLDIERS OR THEIR DEPENDANTS.

Department of Lands and Surveys,
Corr. 1063/18. Perth, 10th September, 1919.

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has been pleased to approve of the following Regulations under the provisions of Section 8 of "The Discharged Soldiers' Settlement Act, 1918."

REGULATIONS.

1. Town and suburban lots set apart under "The Land Act, 1898," for the purpose of being disposed of to discharged holdiers or their dependants may be sold without first being submitted to auction.

2. Applications shall take priority in the order of their being lodged at the Department of Lands and Surveys, Perth, or at such other office as may be notified in the *Government Gazette*.

3. In the event of more than one application being lodged on the day the lots are advertised as open for selection, or on the same day thereafter for any lot unapplied for, the matter shall be referred to the Discharged Soldiers' Land Settlement Board, to decide to whom the lots shall be granted, and its decision shall be final.

4. Applications shall be made in the form of Schedule I. and must be accompanied by 10 per cent. of the purchase price fixed for any lot applied for.

5. If the application is unsuccessful, the deposit of 10 per cent. will be refunded.

6. The balance of the purchase price on a town lot shall be paid by equal half-yearly instalments extending over five years; the first of such instalments to be due on the first of the quarter next following the approval of the application.

7. The balance of the purchase money on a suburban lot shall be paid by equal half-yearly instalments extending over ten years; the first of such instalments to be due on the first of the quarter next following the approval of the application.

8. On approval of the application, a license shall issue in the form of Schedule II., and such license may be transferred or mortgaged as hereinafter provided.

9. No transfer or mortgage will be allowed during the term of the license without the approval of the Discharged Soldiers' Land Settlement Board, and any transfer or mortgage executed without such approval will render the lot liable to forfeiture, together with all moneys paid thereon.

10. No person who has held and transferred a lot under these Regulations will be eligible to obtain another lot under these Regulations, except under special circumstances approved by the Board.

11. Every town lot shall be improved by the erection of a habitable house thereon within twelve months, or such extended time as may be approved by the Minister for Lands, to the value of at least £30, and after the erection of such house, and residence therein by the licensee, further payments will be remitted, and the Crown grant will issue on payment of a Crown grant fee of 30s., free of all restrictions.

12. Every suburban lot shall within five years be fenced to the satisfaction of the Minister for Lands, and otherwise improved to an amount equal to double the purchase money. On completion of such expenditure, further payments will be remitted, and the Crown grant will issue on payment of a Crown grant fee of 30s., free of all restrictions.

13. Failure in any case to comply with the conditions of improvements, as per Clauses (11) and (12), within the time stated will render the land liable to forfeiture in the discretion of the Minister for Lands.

14. The holder of a lease under the "Regulations for the Leasing of Town and Suburban Lands," gazetted on the 24th May, 1918, may surrender his lease and obtain a license under these Regulations, on making application in the form of Schedule III.

15. The application to surrender must be accompanied by the lease, with a surrender thereof in the form of Schedule IV., and the Titles office fee of £1.

16. A sum equal to 10 per cent. of the purchase price, together with all rent accrued to the date of the application to surrender, must be paid with the application, on receipt of which a license will issue, as provided in Clause (7).

17. No person shall hold more than one lot under these Regulations.

18. If, in the discretion of the Discharged Soldiers' Land Settlement Board, a transfer is approved to a person other than a discharged soldier or his dependant, the balance of the purchase money outstanding at the date of transfer must be paid within the time fixed by the Regulations governing the sale of town and suburban lots at auction, and if such time has expired, such balance of purchase money must be paid before the transfer can be approved. In all other respects the provisions of "The Land Act, 1898," and the Regulations thereunder relating to the sale of town and suburban lots shall apply to such transferee.

32. Every person offending against the provision of these By-laws shall forfeit and pay, on conviction, a penalty not exceeding £20.

WHEREAS Model By-laws have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section 267 of "The Health Act, 1911-18," and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 20th day of November, 1914, and whereas the Claremont Road Board being a Local Health Authority under the provisions of the said Act, did by resolution published in the *Government Gazette* on the 14th day of September, 1917, adopt either wholly or in part such model By-laws to be its By-laws, and whereas by the provisions of the said Act a Local Health Authority may alter or amend By-laws so made: Now, therefore, the Claremont Road Board being the Local Health Authority for the Claremont Road District, doth hereby amend such By-laws by the addition of the following By-laws:—

Part IV.—Dairies and Milk Shops.

3A. No person shall carry on the trade of a dairyman or vendor—

- (a) Unless he is the holder of a subsisting license to carry on such trade, issued by the Local Authority; or
- (b) On any premises in respect of which he is for the time being not registered by the Local Health Authority as hereinbefore provided.
- Provided that the foregoing provisions of this By-law shall not apply during the first week in January in any year in respect of a person who was lawfully carrying on the trade at the end of the preceding year.

Part V.—Lodging-houses.

2A. No person shall carry on the trade of a keeper of a lodginghouse—

- (a) Unless he is the holder of a subsisting license to carry on such trade, issued by the Local Health Authority; or
- (b) On any premises in respect of which he is for the time being not registered by the Local Health Authority as hereinbefore provided.
- Provided that the foregoing provisions of this By-law shall not apply during the first week in January in any year in respect of a person who was lawfully carrying on the trade at the end of the preceding year.

Part VI.—Boarding-houses.

3A. No person shall carry on the trade of a keeper of a boarding-house—

- (a) Unless he is the holder of a subsisting license to carry on such trade, issued by the Local Health Authority; or
- (b) On any premises in respect of which he is for the time being not registered by the Local Health Authority as hereinbefore provided.
- Provided that the foregoing provisions of this By-law shall not apply during the first week in January in any year in respect of a person who was lawfully carrying on the trade at the end of the preceding year.

Part X.—Offensive Trades.

3A. No person shall carry on any offensive trade—

- (a) Unless he is the holder of a subsisting license to carry on such trade, issued by the Local Health Authority; or

- (b) On any premises in respect of which he is for the time being not registered by the Local Health Authority as hereinbefore provided.

Provided that the foregoing provisions of this By-law shall not apply during the first week in January in any year in respect of a person who was lawfully carrying on the trade at the end of the preceding year.
