WHEREAS by Sections 222 and 227 of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906" (6 Edwardi, No. 32), it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the *Government Gazette*, to declare any land reserved, used, or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street or way, or any place, bridge, or thoroughfare, to be a public highway, and such land shall thereupon and thenceforth, from the date of such Proclamation, become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force; and whereas the Geraldton Municipal Council has requested that certain land named and described in the Schedule hereunder which has been reserved for street or way within the Municipality of Geraldton, be declared a public highway: Now therefore I, the said Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation declare the said land to be a public highway, and such land shall, from the date of this Proclamation, be absolutely dedicated to the public as a highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 199/22.

WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works, and Storm-water Drainage Works; and whereas it is further provided that the Governor may exempt reticulation works from certain sections of this Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby approves of the construction and extension by the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage of the following works under the said

Act, and does hereby exempt such works from the operations of Sections 20, 21, 22, and 23 of the said Act:—

Description and Location of Reticulation Works approved and exempted.

Fremantle Municipality—Water Supply Improvements.

Proposed 6 inches diameter cast-iron water main along Stephen Street and Church Street, from the 18 inches diameter water main in Swanbourne Street Westerly to Attfield Street (length about 22½ chains), together with valves, hydrants, and all necessary apparatus, as shown in red on Plan W.S., S., & D.D., W.A., No. 4010.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 7th day of April, 1922.
