WHEREAS by Section 9 of "The Land Act, 1898," the Administrator may resume, for any of the purposes specified in Section 39 of the said Act, any portion of land held as a Conditional Purchase: And whereas it is deemed expedient that the portion of Conditional Purchase Lease 35656/55 (Jennaberring A.A. Lot 2), as described hereunder should be resumed for one of the purposes specified in paragraph 8 of Section 39 of the said Act, that is to say, for a Hall Site (Agricultural) and Recreation: Now therefore I, Sir Robert Furse McMillan, Administrator as aforesaid, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation resume portion of C.P. 35656/55 (Jennaberring A.A. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. No. 3055/22.

WHEREAS the enactment contained in Section 74 of "The Constitution Act, 1889," by which the appointment of all Public Officers under the Government of the State is vested in the Governor in Council, does not apply to minor appointments which by Order in Council are vested in heads of departments or other officers or persons within the State: And whereas it is desirable that the minor appointments of all persons who are exempt from the provisions of "The Public Service Act, 1904," employed by the Department of Lands and Surveys should be vested in Reginald George Courtenay (Accountant): Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator in Council, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby declares that the power of making such minor appointments shall vest, and the same is hereby vested in Reginald George Courtenay accordingly.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 815/22.

WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works, and Stormwater Drainage Works; and whereas it is further provided that the Governor may exempt reticulation works from certain sections of this Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby approves of the construction and extension by the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage,

and Drainage of the following works under the said Act, and does hereby exempt such works from the operations of Sections 20, 21, 22, and 23 of the said Act:—

Description and Location of Reticulation Works approved and exempted.

Claremont Road Board District.

Water Supply Improvements and Extension.

Proposed 3-inch diameter cast-iron water main along Alexander Road from Beatrice Road Northerly to Lot 149 (length about 17 chains); together with the lifting of about 7½ chains of existing 1½-inch diameter galvanised wrought iron piping in Alexander Road and relaying in Genesta Crescent from Alexander Road, South-Easterly to Lot 421. Mains to be provided with valves, hydrants, and all necessary apparatus, as shown in red on Plan M.W.S., S., & D.D., W.A., No. 4101.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the tenth day of November, 1922.

The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 773/22.

WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works, and Stormwater Drainage Works: And whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

Cottesloe and Cottesloe Beach Road Board District.

Proposed 24-inch diameter cast-iron Water Main, from Forrest Street to Battle Street, as shown on Plan M.W.S., S., & D.D., W.A., No. 4037.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the tenth day of November, 1922.

The Road Districts Act, 1919.

Augusta, Sussex, and Lower Blackwood Road Districts. Alteration of Boundaries.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 189/21.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," the Governor may, by Order in Council, sever any portion of a Road District and annex it to an existing Road District, and may transfer to one ward of a district any portion of another ward: And whereas it is desirable:—

1. To sever portion of the Sussex Road District and annex it to the Augusta Road District.
2. To sever portion of the Lower Blackwood Road District and annex it to the August Road District.
3. To transfer portion of the West Ward of the Lower Blackwood Road Board to the South Ward.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby:—

1. Sever that portion of the Sussex Road District as described in the Schedule "A" hereto and annex it to the Augusta Road District.
2. Sever that portion of the Lower Blackwood Road District as described in Schedule "B" hereto and annex it to the Augusta Road District.
3. Amend the ward boundaries of the Lower Blackwood Road District by transferring that territory forming the West Ward (after amendment) to the South Ward, and re-naming same the South-West Ward, with a membership of three in lieu of two,

Schedule "A."

AUGUSTA ROAD DISTRICT.

Transfer of Territory from the Sussex Road District.

All that piece of land bounded on the North by lines commencing at the intersection of the shores of the Indian Ocean with the production West of the South boundary of Sussex Location 540, and extending Eastward along said production and South boundary, Southern boundaries of Locations 1052, 1053, and 1081, part of the Western, the South, and the Easternmost boundary of Location 1668, the North boundary of Reserve 1465, and its production East to the South-West boundary of Location 1685, and along parts of the South-West and South-East boundaries of said Location 1685 to the production West of the North boundary of Location 1683, and along said production and North boundary to the North-East corner of said Location 1683; thence Eastward to the North corner of Location 1692; thence along part of the South-West, the South-Eastern, and part of the North-Eastern boundary of Location 1694 to an East and West line passing through the 34 M.P. on the Margaret River telegraph line, and Eastward along said line to the said 34 M.P.; thence Eastward to the North-West corner of Location 742 and along its North boundary, part of the West and the South boundary of Location 528 to its South-East corner; thence Eastward to and along the South boundary of Location 706, part of the West and the North boundary of Location 707, the North boundary of Location 708; thence Northward along the production Northward of the East boundary of said Location 708 to the production Westward of the South boundary of Location 696, and Eastward along the latter production and the South and part of the East boundary of said Location 696 to the production West of the South boundary of Location 855, and along said production and South boundary and the East and part of the North boundary of said Location 855, the East boundary of Location 854 to its North-East corner; thence Eastward to the intersection of the South-Western side of Road No. 114 with the West boundary of Reserve 14787, and along parts of the West and South boundaries of said Reserve 14787 to the North-Western side of Jarrahwood-Nannup Railway Reserve, and along said side of the Railway Reserve to the North boundary of Timber Concession 191F, and along part of the North boundary of said timber concession to the present District boundary at the North-West corner of Pastoral Lease 371/93.

On the South-Eastward, Southward, and Westward by part of the present boundaries of the Sussex Road District, from the North-West corner of said Pastoral Lease 371/93 to the starting point.

Inclusive of all islands adjacent thereto.

NINGHAN ROAD BOARD.

Buildings By-laws.

WHEREAS by "The Road Districts Act, 1919," the Road Board of any district is empowered to make By-laws for all or any purposes under the above-mentioned Act, the Ninghan Road Board, in pursuance of powers vested under the said Act and of every other authority enabling it in that behalf, doth hereby make the following, which shall be known and cited as "The Buildings By-laws":—

1. *Interpretation.*—Unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms shall bear the meaning set against them:—

- "Board"—The Ninghan Road Board.
- "District"—The Ninghan Road District.
- "Building"—Any house, store, shop, stable, shed, verandah, lean-to, bough shed or tent.
- "Owner"—The owner of any land as interpreted under the provisions of "The Road Districts Act, 1919."
- "Builder"—Any builder, contractor, painter, or person engaged in the erection of any "building" within the meaning of these By-laws.
- "Townsite"—Any townsite situated within the Ninghan Road District.
- "Footpath" shall include any part of a street set apart for the sole use of pedestrians, and whether the footpath be made or kerbed or otherwise.
- "Chairman"—The Chairman of the Ninghan Road Board.
- "Secretary"—The Secretary to the Ninghan Road Board.

2. No owner or builder within the meaning of these By-laws shall erect any building upon any land in any townsite within the District, unless he first submit to the Board a copy of the plans and specifications of the building to be erected, and setting out clearly the number of buildings proposed to be built on each particular townsite lot or parcel of land, the measurements, materials of construction, and use for which the building is intended.

3. No building shall be commenced unless a copy of the plans and specifications shall have been laid before and approved by the Board, and such copy of the plans and specifications shall receive approval by endorsement set thereto by the hands of the Chairman and Secretary.

4. The Board may reject any plans or specifications which have not, by reason of inflammable material proposed to be used or other reason, proper regard for the safety of persons or other buildings in event of fire.

5. The Board may reject any plans or specifications which, in the opinion of the Board, do not bear proper consideration of size or design of construction or architecture to the adjacent buildings, and which would have a depreciative effect on such adjacent buildings.

6. No builder or owner shall open up any road or footpath which by reason of building operations is found necessary, unless he first obtain a permit from the Board, and such openings shall be covered or railed and provided with lights to ensure safety to the general public using the road or footpath.

7. Every builder or owner shall, within reasonable time from the completion of any building, fill in and repair to the satisfaction of the Board's authorised inspecting officer all openings on any road or footpath which, by reason of building operations, it has been found necessary to open.

8. No verandah shall be erected over any footpath unless it be at least eight feet in height above the footpath, and if supporting posts be used these shall be placed eleven feet from the building line to the outside of the posts, and as close to the kerbing as the Board may direct to conform with the footpath width of eleven feet.

9. Any person who does any act contrary to, or neglects or omits to do any act required to be done within the meaning of these By-laws shall incur a penalty not exceeding Twenty-five pounds, and a further penalty of not more than Twenty shillings for each day the offence continues.

Subject to the approval of His Excellency the Governor-in-Council, these By-laws shall come into force from the date of publication in the *Government Gazette*.
