Heavy Traffic By-law.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

UNDER the provisions of Section 42 of "The Traffic Act, 1919," His Excellency the Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby empower the Sussex Road Board to make a By-law prohibiting the passage of heavy traffic over and along certain roads within its District, in the terms set out in the Schedule hereto:—

Schedule.

1. The passage of any vehicle engaged in "heavy traffic" over any of the roads specified hereunder is hereby prohibited during the months of June, July, August, September, and October in every year:—

1. Bumbury Road
2. Chapman's Hill Road, No. 3246
3. Jalbarragup Road, No. 1180
4. Kaloorup Road
5. Margaret Road, No. 330
6. Quindalup Road, No. 3227
7. St. John's Brook Road, No. 114
8. Wildwood-Abbey's Road, No. 793.

2. Any person infringing this Regulation or being party or privy to any infringement shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding £20.

(2) Sever that portion of the Irwin Road District as described in Schedule "B" hereto and annex it to the Mingenev Road District.

(3) Sever that portion of the Mingenev Road District as amended by Schedule "A" and "B" therefrom, as described in Schedule "C" hereto, and constitute such severed portion a Road District to be called the Carnamah Road District.

(4) Divide the said Carnamah Road District into five Wards, with the names, boundaries, and number of members, allocated as described in Schedule "D" hereto.

(5) Divide the Mingenev Road District into five Wards, with the names, boundaries, and number of members allocated as described in Schedule "E" hereto.

(6) Divide the Irwin Road District into three Wards, with the names, boundaries, and number of members allocated as described in Schedule "F" hereto.

(7) Appoint Mr. Richard Robertson as the Returning Officer at the election of the members of the Carnamah Road Board, and to fix the dates for the various events leading up to the said election, as shown in Schedule "G" hereto.
