## ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 229/23.

WHEREAS by Order in Council published in the *Government Gazette* on the 21st day of September, 1923, certain dates were fixed for the preparation of electoral rolls and the holding of the Revision Court in the Chittering Road District and for taking certain proceedings in connection therewith: And whereas the said Order has not been carried into effect in respect of such matters, and the rolls prepared in the month of March, 1923, remain in force, and it is necessary to provide for the representation on the Chittering Road Board of the electors in the newly constituted Muchea Ward thereon: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor doth hereby, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, order and direct as follows:—

1. The owners or occupiers as on the 1st day of July, 1923, of rateable land in that part of the Chittering Road District which constitutes the Muchea Ward thereof shall be qualified and admitted subject to this Order as electors for the said Ward.

2. The Road Board of the said District shall forthwith, and without holding any Revision Court, prepare a roll for the said Ward, and shall place thereon the names of all owners of rateable land who are by this Order admitted as electors, subject to the right (which is hereby conferred) of any occupier of land qualified as an elector under this Order to be placed on the roll in lieu of the owner thereof, on making application to the Board.

3. Before preparing such roll the Board shall insert in some newspaper circulating in the district at least five days' notice of their intention to prepare such roll, and shall by such notice invite owners or occupiers claiming to be placed on the roll to send in notice of their claims to the Board: Provided that nothing herein shall be deemed to prevent the Board from placing on the roll the name of any qualified owner, although no notice of his claim shall have been sent to the Board.

4. The said roll when prepared shall be certified as correct by the Chairman, and his certificate shall be conclusive.

5. The roll so certified shall be used as the electoral roll for the said Ward until the preparation of a new roll under "The Road Districts Act, 1919."
