*Election of the Elective Members of the Public Service Appeal Board.*

1. *Election Day.*—In compliance with the provisions of Regulation 3 of the Supplementary Regulations under "The Public Service Act, 1904," I hereby give notice of, and appoint *Saturday, the twenty-second day of December, 1923, to be the day upon which an Election will be held at the Chief Electoral Office, Supreme Court Buildings, Perth, for the purpose of electing one Representative and one Deputy Representative for each Division of the Public Service, that is to say, the Administrative, the Professional, the Clerical, and the General.* The members elected will hold office for two years from the 1st January, 1924.

Nomination papers will be supplied by the Returning Officer upon application.

3. *The Poll.*—A Poll will be proceeded with for each vacancy for which, on Nomination Day, more than one Candidate has been duly nominated.

INSPECTION OF MACHINERY ACT, 1921.

Department of Mines,  
Perth, 15th November, 1923.  
HIS Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 82 of the "Inspection of Machinery Act, 1921," has been pleased to amend the following Regulations and Schedules under the said Act.

*Engine Room Record Book.*

Regulation 3.—Cancel the Regulation and substitute the following:—

"3. In the case of Winding Engines, in addition to the provisions contained in Regulations 1 and 2, every driver, on the completion of his shift, shall make an entry in the Record Book concerning the general running of the engine, and the condition of the brakes, depth indicators, and clutches, for the information of the succeeding driver."

*Regulations relating to Passenger and Goods Lifts.*

Regulation 1.—In the fourth line, after the word "plans," insert the words "drawn to scale," and after the word "placed," in the last line, add the following:—

"The maximum load for which the lift is designed must also be stated. When submitting plans and specifications, these must be accompanied by a fee of £1 ls. for examining them and granting a permit to proceed with erection. No erection work shall be commenced until permit has been granted."

Regulation 3.—Delete the following words: "When the plans have to be submitted, they must be accompanied by a fee of £1 ls. for inspecting them and granting a permit to proceed with erection."

Regulation 9.—Cancel the Regulation and substitute the following:—

"9. Safety grip gear to the satisfaction of the Inspector is to be provided in the case of every suspended lift, except in the case of service or other small lifts in which it is impossible for any person to travel. The grip gear must be automatic and positive in its action, and must be able to hold the cage or platform securely in case the suspending ropes break or become detached. The grip gear must also be operable by the action of an adjustable speed governor, in case any undue acceleration occurs through overloading or in consequence of the failure of any part of the winding gear.

Provided that this Regulation be not enforced in the case of lifts already installed before the commencement of this Act, at the discretion of the Inspector."

Regulation 13.—In the first paragraph, delete the word "gradually," and insert in lieu thereof the word "satisfactorily." In the second paragraph delete the word "gradual."

Regulation 14.—In the second line, after the words "current and," insert the words "in the case of electrically operated brakes."

Regulation 33.—In the third line, delete all the words after the word "attendant," and insert in lieu thereof the words "can efficiently control the ingress and egress of passengers."

Regulation 48.—In the second paragraph, delete all the words after the word "posted," and insert in lieu thereof the words "conspicuously in the cage."

*Regulations relating to the Conduct of Examinations, Qualifications of Applicants, and the Granting of Certificates to Engine-drivers, Crane and Hoist Drivers, and Boiler Attendants.*

Regulation 5 (c).—In the third line delete the word "and," after the word "employer," and insert in lieu thereof the word "or," and in the second to last line delete the word and figures "twelve (12)," and in lieu thereof insert the word and figure "six (6)."

Regulation 5 (d).—In the second line delete the word "and," and insert in lieu thereof the word "or," and in the sixth line, after the words "the area of the," insert the words "cylinder or."

2. When demand has been made under Section 285 of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," the Secretary shall forthwith prepare a special roll of the names of all persons who appear to be resident owners of rateable land within the meaning of the said section.

3. The said roll shall be in the Form A in the Schedule hereto, and shall be available for inspection by any ratepayer, at the Board's office, within the usual office hours, not later than fourteen days before the date fixed for the holding of the poll.

4. On or before the tenth day before the day fixed for taking the poll, any resident owner—

- (a) whose name has not been inserted in the roll may, by letter delivered or sent through the post, addressed to the Secretary, apply to have his name inserted therein, and shall give particulars of his claim;
- (b) whose name has been inserted in the roll, and who is dissatisfied with such roll as not specifying the full rateable value of the land owned or leased by him, may, in like manner, apply to the Secretary, and have the amount of such rateable value altered, and shall give particulars of his claim;
- (c) whose name appears in the roll, or who claims to have his name inserted in such roll, may, in like manner, object to the name of any other person as not being entitled to have his name retained therein, or as not being entitled to have the number of votes set against his name;
- (d) Any such claims or objections shall be as prescribed in Forms B, C, D, and E in the Schedule, or to the like effect, and any objections under paragraph (c) shall be made in duplicate by the person objecting, and it shall be the duty of the Secretary to send one of such notices to the person objected to.

5. The Board shall hold an open Court, to be called a Revision Court, within the Road Board District, for the purpose of revising the roll.

6. Seven days' notice of the time and place fixed for the holding of such court shall be exhibited at the office of the Board, and so far as practicable by advertisement in a newspaper circulating in the District.


