AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, Perth, this 26th day of November, 1923, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

The Stock Diseases Act, 1895.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by "The Stock Diseases Act, 1895," the Governor is empowered, by Order in Council to be published in the *Government Gazette* from time to time, to make, vary, alter, or revoke such Regulations under the said Act as may be deemed necessary for any of the purposes mentioned in the said Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him as aforesaid, and acting by and with the consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby alter the Regulations made under the aforesaid Act and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 23rd day of November, 1923, by inserting, in the last line of Regulation 7 thereof, the word "swine" after the word "goats"; and doth amend the quarantine area defined in the schedule to the Regulations referred to, by excluding

therefrom the land described in the schedule hereunder:—

The Schedule.

That portion to the Northward of a line commencing at the intersection of the production Westward of the Northern side of Marine Terrace with the shores of the Indian Ocean, and extending Eastward along said production and Northern side of Marine Terrace to the Western side of Cliff Street, and along said side of Cliff Street to the Northern side of High Street; thence along said side of High Street and the Western side of Market Street to the production South-Westward of the North-Western side of Cantonment Street; thence North-Eastward along said production and side of Cantonment Street to the South-Western side of Edward Street, and North-Westward along said side of Edward Street to the South-Eastern side of Beach Street, and along said side of Beach Street to the North corner of Fremantle Lot 276; thence along the production North-Westward of the North-Eastern boundary of said Lot 276 to the left bank of the Swan River.
