## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by Subsection (5) of Section 102 of "The Factories and Shops Act, 1920," that it shall be lawful for shops to which the said section applies (except those in certain districts named in the subsection) to remain open until nine o'clock on one evening in the week, subject to the provisions of the said subsection, and that the Governor may from time to time by Proclamation, issued on the petition of a majority of the shopkeepers affected, determine the day on which such shops shall so remain open in each week for any district: And whereas a petition has been presented to the Governor by a majority of the keepers of such shops in the Shop District of Norseman, praying that the day on which such shops in such district shall remain open till nine o'clock in the evening shall be Thursday, and it is desirable to accede to the prayer of such petition: Now therefore I, the said Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim and determine that, subject to the said Act, the day in each week on which all such shops as aforesaid in the said District shall remain open till nine o'clock in the evening shall be Thursday.

## PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency Sir Francis Alex-

Governor. in and over the State of Western  
Australia and its Dependencies in  
[L.S.] the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by Section 9 of "The Fisheries Act, 1905-13," it is provided that the Governor may, by proclamation, prohibit all persons from taking any fish whatsoever, in every or any specified portion of Western Australian waters, by means of fishing nets and fishing lines, or either of such means of capture or by any other specified means of capture, for any specified term: Now therefore I, the said Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby, in exercise of the powers aforesaid and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, proclaim and declare as follows:—

That all those portions of Western Australian waters defined in the Schedule hereto shall be closed against the use of fishing nets as from the date of the publication of this proclamation in the *Government Gazette* until the 31st day of December, 1924, inclusive.

*Schedule.*

1. That area of water at Cottesloe, on the Southern side of the Cottesloe Pier, extending in a Southerly direction a quarter of a mile and in a Westerly direction a quarter of a mile.
2. That area of water at Cottesloe, on the Northern side of the Cottesloe Pier, extending in a Northerly direction one half mile and in a Westerly direction a quarter of a mile.

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 87/23; Ex. Co. No. 5004.

WHEREAS by Section 11 of "The Public Works Act, 1902," it is made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, to authorise the Minister to undertake, construct, or provide any Public Work (subject as to Railways to Section 96), and such authorisation shall be deemed an authority to such Minister by and under that Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the power conferred by the recited section of "The Public Works Act, 1902," doth hereby authorise the Honourable Minister for Works to construct works for the conservation of water at Newdegate, and to provide Water Catchments in connection therewith, on the land shown edged pink on Plans P.W.D. W.A., 22833, P.W.D. W.A., 22790, and P.W.D. W.A., 22798, which may be inspected at the office of the Minister for Works, Perth.

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 316/24.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 212 of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," that land declared by the Governor to be exempt from rates shall not be rateable property within the meaning of the said Act: And whereas it is desirable to exempt from rates the land hereinafter described: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the power vested in him by Section 212 of the said Act, doth hereby declare that the land described in the Schedule hereunder and situated within the Murray Road District, shall be exempt from rates under the aforesaid Act:—

*Heavy Traffic By-Law.*

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 600/24.

UNDER the provisions of Section 42 of "The Traffic Act, 1919," His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby empower the Murray Road Board to make a By-law prohibiting the passage of heavy traffic over and along certain roads within its district, in the terms set out in the Schedule hereto.

#### *Schedule.*

1. The passage of any vehicle engaged in "heavy traffic" over any of the roads specified hereunder is

prohibited during the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, and October in every year:—

- (a) The road leading from Mandurah Bridge towards Pinjarra to Block No. 108, a distance of 93 chains.
- (b) The road leading from Mandurah Bridge along Mandurah Terrace to the junction of the road leading to Peninsula Hotel, a distance of 51 chains.
- (c) At the junction of the Mandurah-Pinjarra Road, commencing at the Post Office Block and thence North along Sholl Street, a distance of 49 chains.

2. Any person infringing this Regulation or being party or privy to any infringement shall be liable, on summary conviction, to a penalty not exceeding £20.
