WHEREAS by Sections 222 and 227 of "The Muni-
cipal Corporations Act, 1906" (6 Edwardi, No. 32), it
shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the
Council, by notice in the *Government Gazette*, to declare
any land reserved, used, or by purchase or exchange
acquired for a street or way, or any place, bridge, or
thoroughfare, to be a public highway, and such land
shall thereupon and thenceforth, from the date of such
Proclamation, become and be absolutely dedicated to
the public as a public highway, within the meaning of
any law now or hereafter in force: And whereas the
City of Perth Municipal Council has requested that cer-
tain land named and described in the Schedule here-
under, which has been used for a street or way within
the Municipality of the City of Perth, be declared a
public highway: Now, therefore I, the said Governor,
by and with the advice and consent of the Executive

Council, do by this my Proclamation declare the said land to be a public highway, and such land shall, from the date of this Proclamation, be absolutely dedicated to the public as a highway, within the meaning of any law nor or hereafter in force.

WHEREAS by Section 4 of "The Vermin Act, 1918," it is enacted that "Vermin" means and includes any animal or bird mentioned in the Third Schedule to this Act, and such other animals or birds the names of which the Governor may by Proclamation add to the said schedule; and also that any Proclamation whereby the names of other animals or birds are added to the said Schedule may be restricted in its operation to any portion of the State to be defined by the Proclamation: And whereas it is deemed expedient to add the name of animals known as Red Kangaroos (*M. rufus*) to the Third Schedule of the said Act, but to restrict this Proclamation in its operation to Port Hedland Vermin District: Now therefore I, the said Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do hereby add to the said Third Schedule to the said Act the name of animals known as Red Kangaroos (*M. rufus*) for the purposes of the said Act, but this Proclamation shall be restricted in its operation to that portion of the State constituted and known as Port Hedland Vermin District for the purposes of the said Act.

Constitution of Northampton Health District under the provisions of "The Health Act, 1911-19."

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.P.H. 1620/19; Ex. Co. No. 1177.

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 19 of "The Health Act, 1911-19," that the Governor may constitute any portion of the State, not being a Municipal District, to be a Health District, with such boundaries and by such name as may be specified in the Order: And whereas it is desired to constitute portion of the Northampton Road District a Health District under the said Act:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby constitute the area of land embraced within the undermentioned boundaries (being portion of the area comprised in the said Road District) to be a Health District by the name of the Northampton Health District, under the provisions of "The Health Act, 1911-19":—

All that portion of land contained within the following boundaries:—Bounded by a line commencing from the South-West corner of Location 1709; thence in an Easterly direction along the boundary of the Northampton townsite; thence in a Southerly direction to the North-West corner of Location 6845; thence along the Northern boundary to a point where it meets with the town boundary; thence along the town boundary in an Easterly direction; thence in a Southerly direction; thence in a Westerly direction; thence in a Southerly direction; thence in a Southerly direction to the South-Eastern corner of the Northampton Townsite; thence in a Westerly direction to the South-Western corner of Location 325; thence in a Northerly direction to the North-West corner of Location 2124; thence in an Easterly direction to the boundary of Lot 183; thence in a Northerly direction to the South-East corner of Location 2095; thence along the Southern, Western, and Northern boundaries of Location 2095 to the boundary of Location 2094; thence in a Northerly and Easterly direction along the boundaries of Location 2094 to the boundary of Location 183; thence in a Northerly and Easterly direction along the boundaries of Location 183; thence in a Northerly direction along the Western boundary of Locations 27 and 37; thence in an Easterly direction along the Northern boundary of Location 37 to the North-West corner of Location 3709; thence in a Southerly direction to the starting point. Also all that area of land contained within Lot 1146.

Abolition of Northampton Health District under the provisions of "The Health Act, 1911-19."

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 19 of "The Health Act, 1911-19," that the Governor may abolish any Health District constituted by the Governor under the said Act: And whereas it is desired to abolish the Health District which was so constituted: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby abolish the Northampton Health District.

The Inspection of Scaffolding Act, 1924 (as amended).

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS His Excellency the Governor in Council may make Regulations under the provisions of "The Inspection of Scaffolding Act, 1924," as amended: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor in Council, acting in pursuance of such powers and on the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Regulation:—

Regulation 5A.

When sawn timber is used for external or internal scaffolding for bricklayers, plasterers, and other persons engaged in such like work, and such scaffolding is not more than twelve feet high and the standards used therein are in one length and not less than four inches by two inches, and are placed not more than six feet apart, and in other respects are in accordance with the requirements of paragraph 1 of Regulation 5 of the Regulations in the Schedule to "The Inspection of Scaffolding Act, 1924," then ledgers not less than four inches by two inches may be used on such scaffolding; provided that the first ledger is not more than five feet above the ground level and all the ledgers are securely bolted to standards with iron bolts not less than one-half inch in diameter with washers, and properly tightened up.

And provided also, that this regulation shall be supplementary to and be read in conjunction with Regula-

tion 5 of the said Regulations as if the same were included therein and numbered 5A.

Quairading Road District.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 1489/27.

WHEREAS by Section 202 of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," it is enacted that the Governor may in his discretion extend the provisions set out in the Second Schedule of the said Act to any district or portion thereof: And whereas it is desirable to extend such provisions to portions of the Quairading Road District: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth by this Order in Council, made under Section 202 of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," extend such provisions set out in the Second Schedule of the said Act to those portions of the Quairading Road District as described in Schedule hereto.

The Road Districts Act, 1919.

Perenjori-Morawa Road District—Formation of Morawa Road District and Division into Wards.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 35/26.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," the Governor may by Order in Council sever any portion of a Road District therefrom and constitute such severed portion a Road District, and may divide a District into Wards: And whereas it is desirable to—(1) sever portion of the Perenjori-Morawa Road District and constitute such severed portion a Road District, to be called the Morawa Road District; (2)

divide the Morawa Road District into four Wards; (3) re-name the Perenjori-Morawa Road District (as amended) and call it the Perenjori Road District, and redivide the Perenjori Road District into five Wards: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the provisions of the said Act and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby—(1) sever portion of the Perenjori-Morawa Road District, as described in Schedule A hereto, and constitute such severed portion a Road District, to be called the Morawa Road District; (2) divide the Morawa Road District into four Wards, with the names, boundaries, and number of members allotted to each Ward as described in Schedule B hereto; (3) rename the Perenjori-Morawa Road District, as amended by Schedule A, and call it the Perenjori Road District; and redivide the Perenjori Road District into five Wards, with the names, boundaries, and number of members allotted to each Ward, as described in Schedule C hereto.

To come into force on the 1st day of July, 1928.

Schedule A.

Morawa Road District.

Transfer of Territory from the Perenjori-Morawa Road District.

All that piece of land at present forming portion of the Perenjori-Morawa Road District, bounded on the Northward by lines commencing at the North-East corner of Lot M1277 of Victoria Location 2014 and extending Eastward along part of the present district boundary to a North-East corner of pastoral lease 2754/93; on the Eastward by lines commencing at the latter North-East corner and extending Southward along the Easternmost and a South boundary of said Pastoral Lease 2754/93 and the West boundary of Victoria Location 8582 and part of the West boundary of Location 7889 to the North-East corner of Victoria Location 7877; on the Southward by lines commencing at the said North-East corner and extending Westward along the North boundaries of Victoria Locations 7877, 7715, 8571, 8624 and again a North boundary of Location 8571, part of the East, the North and part of the West boundary of Location 7676, the Northern and Western boundaries of Location 3697, part of the North boundary of Location 4335, the Northern boundaries of Locations 6298, 6297, 6296, 6295, 7418, 6317, 8210, and 6225, the Eastern boundaries of Locations 6779, 6224, and 6314, the North boundaries of Locations 5479 and 5483, and their production West through Location 2019 to its West boundary, and North along part of said West boundary to the North-West corner of the said Location, thence by part of the North boundary of Location 2018 to intersect the production South of the East boundary of Location 4120; on the Westward by part of the present district boundary from the said intersection to the starting point.

Morawa Road District.

Description of Ward Boundaries.

Merkanooka Ward.—Bounded on the Westward and Northward by part of the district boundary from its intersection with the production West of the North boundary of Location 7597 to its intersection with the Western side of the Wongan Hills-Mullewa Railway Reserve; on the Eastward by lines commencing at the last-mentioned intersection and extending Southward along the Western side of the railway reserve to the North boundary of Location 5530, thence along parts of the North and East boundaries of said Location 5530, the North, the East, and the Southernmost boundary of Location 5522, part of the East boundary of Location 7147, a North-East and a North boundary of Location 5511, the North, the North-East and the North-West boundary of Location 5510, a West boundary of Location 5509, the West boundary of Location 7198, part of the North boundary of Location 5500, the North, the East, and part of the South boundary of Location 5506, thence along the Western side of the railway reserve to a South-East corner of Location 5501, and to and along the North-East, the East and part of the South boundary of Location 5502, the Eastern and Southernmost boundaries of Location 5503, part of the East boundary of Location 5495, the Southern boundary of Location 5494, and part of the Southern boundary of Location 5493, a South-Western, a North-Western and

again a South-Western boundary of Location 4102, the South-Western boundaries of Locations 4104, 6729 and 8049, the North boundary of Location 3879, and the East boundary of Location 4105 to the South-East corner of the last-mentioned Location; on the Southward by lines commencing at the last-mentioned South-East corner and extending Westward along the South boundaries of Locations 4105, 4106, 4093, 8344 and 4090, part of the East and the South boundary of Location 3884, the South boundary of Location 3883, part of the Eastern, the South, and part of the West boundary of Location 3882, the South and a West boundary of Location 4526, the West boundary of Location 7363, part of the Western boundary of Location 4872, the South boundary of Location 4871, part of the East and South boundary of Location 3971, and the South boundary of Location 3850 and 3849, the West and part of the South boundary of Location 3876, part of the West boundary of Location 4524, and the North boundary of Location 7597 and its production Westward to the starting point (2 members).

Gutha Ward.—Bounded on the Northward and Eastward by part of the district boundary from its intersection with the Eastern boundary of the Merkanooka Ward to the South-West corner of Pastoral Lease 206/97, on the Southward by lines commencing at the said South-Western corner and extending Westward to the North-East corner of Location 8429 and along the Northern boundaries of Locations 8429 and 5995, and part of the Western boundary of the latter, the Northern boundary of Location 5993, the Northern and the West boundary of Location 5992, the West boundary of Location 6312, part of the Northern and Western boundaries of Location 6302, the North boundary of Location 6311, and to and along the South boundary of Location 6640, part of the South boundary of Location 6641, the East, South-Eastern and Southern boundaries of Location 8119, part of the East boundary of Location 3935, and the South boundary of Location 3879 to the Eastern boundary of the Merkanooka Ward at the South-East corner of Location 4105; on the Westward by the Eastern boundary of the Merkanooka Ward to the starting point (1 member).

Morawa Ward.—Bounded on the Northward by the South boundary of the Merkanooka Ward from its intersection with the district boundary to the South-East corner of Location 4105; on the Eastward by lines commencing at the said South-East corner and extending Southward to and along the Western side of the Wongan Hills-Mullewa Railway Reserve to the North boundary of the Morawa Townsite, and along part of the North, the East, and part of the South boundary of said townsite, and again along the Western side of the railway reserve and continuing along the East boundaries of Locations 3919, 3926 and 3927 and their production South to intersect the district boundary; on the Southward and Westward by portion of the district boundary to the starting point (2 members).

Koolanooka Ward.—Bounded on the Northward by the South boundary of the Gutha Ward and by part of the district boundary, and on the Eastward and Southward by portions of the district boundary, and on the Westward by the East boundary of the Morawa Ward (2 members).

Perenjori Road District.

Description of Ward Boundaries.

Bowgada Ward.—Bounded on the Westward and Northward by part of the district boundary from its intersection with the production West of the North boundary of Victoria Location 3894 to the North-Eastern corner of Location 6317.

On the Eastward by lines commencing at the said North-Eastern corner and extending Southward along the Eastern boundaries of Locations 6317 and 6316, the North and East boundaries of the Bowgada Townsite, part of the North boundary of Location 5470, the North boundary of Location 8021, the Northernmost, the East and part of the Southernmost boundary of Location 5468, the East boundary of Location 5471, the North boundary of Location 5477 to the Eastern side of the Wongan Hills-Mullewa Railway Reserve; thence Southward along the said side of the Railway Reserve to the North boundary of Location 6775, and along the Northern boundary of the said Location 6775, the West and Southernmost boundaries of Location 4738, part of the West and the South boundary of Reserve 18848, part of the West and the South boundary of the Perenjori Townsite, the West boundary of Location 4769, part of the North boundary of Location 4766 to the Western side of the railway reserve and Southward along said side of railway reserve to the South-Eastern corner of Location 6256.

On the Southward by lines commencing at the said South-Eastern corner and extending Westward along the South boundaries of Locations 6256 and 4760, part of the East and the South boundary of Location 4762 and Westward to and along the North boundary of Location 3894 and its production Westward to the starting point (2 members).

Perenjori Ward.—Bounded on the Northward and Eastward by part of the district boundary from the North-Eastern corner of the Bowgada Ward to a South-Eastern corner of Pastoral Lease 2729/93.

Alteration in Navigation Marks in "Naval Base" Channel across Success Bank.

NOTICE TO MARINERS.

FURTHER to Notice to Mariners issued by the Fremantle Harbour Trust Commissioners dated 28th March, 1927, and published in the *Government Gazette* of 1st April, 1927, describing the Naval Base Channel across Success Bank between Gage Roads and Owen Anchorage, which has been adopted in place of the old routes

across this bank, now closed, the Commissioners now notify, for the information of those navigating vessels across Success Bank, that the undermentioned alteration has been made in the navigation leading marks for the Channel, as follows, viz.:—

The two pile beacons placed on the centre line of the Channel at its Southern end, one thousand feet distant from one another, for use as transit leads, have been altered by the Southernmost of these two marks being changed from a single pile holding a triangular beacon 16 feet above low water, to a three pile dolphin holding up an iron tripod on which is mounted a single pole with an inverted triangular beacon on top 36 feet above low water; the Northernmost mark has been altered by the triangular beacon mark being made an ordinary triangle in place of an inverted triangle as previously.

Both beacon marks are painted black and white in alternate horizontal stripes.
