WHEREAS by Section 13 of "The Main Roads Act 1925," the Governor may on the recommendation of the Board declare by Proclamation that any road shall be a main road: And whereas the Main Roads Board has recommended that the road specified in the Schedule hereto be so declared: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby declares that the road specified in the Schedule hereto shall be a main road within the meaning of "The Main Roads Act, 1925," and that the footpaths, if any, of such road be excluded from the main road.

The Schedule.

Armada-Pemberton Road. (Bunbury and Dardanup Road Board Districts).

That portion of Road No. 50 (as shown on Lands Department Lithograph 411/80) commencing at Pieton Junction at the Eastern boundary of Lot 243; thence continuing in an Easterly and South-Easterly direction along Road No. 50 to the South-Western Railway; thence crossing the said Railway at this point to its Southern side and continuing along Road No. 50 in a South-Easterly direction through Location 53, Reserve 421A, to the Bunbury-Boyanup Railway in Location 10; thence continuing in a South-Easterly and Southerly direction along Road No. 50 to the said railway; thence continuing in a South-Easterly direction to the Western boundary of Location 307 at the Eastern boundary of the Bunbury Road Board District; thence continuing from the Eastern boundary of the Bunbury Road Board District, at the Eastern boundary of Location 10, along Road No. 50 in a South-Easterly direction to Copplestone Siding; thence crossing the Bunbury-Boyanup Railway at this point to its Southern side, following the said railway in a South-Easterly and Southerly direction along Road No. 50 to the North-Western corner of Lot 26; thence continuing in a Southerly and South-Easterly direction to the North-Eastern corner of Lot 33 at the Western side of the Bunbury-Boyanup Railway; thence continuing in a Southerly direction along Road No. 51, following the said railway on its Western side past Dardanup Railway Station to McParlane Siding at the South-Eastern corner of Location 709; thence continuing in a South-Westerly direction, following the Bunbury-Boyanup Railway on its Western side, crossing Crooked Brook and continuing to the angle on the South-Eastern boundary of Location 822; thence crossing the said railway at this point to its Eastern side and continuing in a South-Westerly direction along the boundary of part Location 822 to the Preston River at the Western boundary of the Dardanup Road Board District, as shown on Plan M.R.B., W.A., No. 356.

THE ROAD DISTRICTS ACT, 1919.

General By-laws, Forms, etc.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted by "The Road Districts Act, 1919," that the Governor may make By-laws for giving effect to the said Act and prescribing the forms for use under the said Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Western Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, make the following additions to the Regulations and forms published in the *Government Gazette* on the 4th July, 1924, as prescribed in the Schedule hereinafter set forth, and such shall apply to and be carried out by all Road Boards throughout the State of Western Australia.

SCHEDULE.

Form 101.

NOTE.—The National Bank intimates that they do not receive credits marked to be applied for any specific purpose. Should such be received by any Officer, the Bank accepts no responsibility for misapplication.

Directions for Secretary.

1. This book is prepared with an original and a duplicate form to be used by means of a carbon sheet, so as to obtain a permanent and uniform means of recording every cheque received by the Board.
2. The original is perforated in order to be detached for the Bank and the carbon duplicate retained in the book, to be initialed and stamped by the Teller at the time when the deposit is made.
3. The date that the cheque is received must be entered in the first column provided for the purpose.
4. No erasure whatsoever shall be made in this Book.
5. Alterations, when necessary, shall be effected by striking out the incorrect entry and inserting in lieu thereof the necessary amendment in ink, date of same, and initials of Board's Officer.

If care and precision are used in maintaining details of this banking, it will afford a valuable protection to the Secretary and all concerned.

This book must not be defaced or mutilated in any way, and must be given up on demand to the current members of the Local Authority or the Minister for Works for the State.
