Greenmount Road Board—Increase in Membership.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 1027/24.

WHEREAS under "The Road Districts Act, 1919," the Governor may from time to time by Order in Council declare and determine the number of members constituting a Road Board, and the number of members for each Ward of the District: And whereas it is desired to increase the number of members of the Greenmount Road Board from eight to nine and to allocate the additional member to the Bellevue Ward of the Greenmount Road District: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the provisions of the said Act, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby declare and determine that the number of members constituting the Greenmount Road Board shall be nine in lieu of eight as heretofore, and that the additional member shall be allocated to the Bellevue Ward of the Greenmount Road District.

The Wards and representation of the District will then be as shown in the Schedule hereto.

Bellevue Ward—3 members; Glen Forrest Ward—2 members; Mundaring Ward—2 members; Chidlow Ward—2 members. Total—9 members.

The Vermin Act, 1918.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 14 of "The Vermin Act, 1918," that the Governor may by Order in Council abolish a District and dissolve the Board thereof, and also may constitute any defined portion of the State a Vermin District for the purposes of the Act, and specify the boundaries of any such district: And whereas it is further enacted by Section 45 of the said Act

that the Governor may appoint the Board of any Road District to be the Board of any Vermin District the boundaries whereof are the same as those of the Road District, or which is comprised within the Road District: And whereas by an Order in Council published in the *Government Gazette* on the 6th day of June, 1919, the Governor constituted that portion of the Perenjori-Morawa Road District, which is situated within the South-West Division of the State a Vermin District, under the name of the Perenjori-Morawa Vermin District, and appointed the Perenjori-Morawa Road Board to be the Vermin Board of the said Vermin District: And whereas the said Perenjori-Morawa Road District has since been divided into two separate road districts, known respectively as the Perenjori Road District and the Morawa Road District: And whereas it is now deemed expedient to abolish the said Perenjori-Morawa Vermin District and to abolish the said Vermin Board, and in lieu thereof to constitute that portion of the State now comprised within the Perenjori Road District as now constituted a Vermin District for the purposes of the said Act, under the name of the Perenjori Vermin District, and to appoint the Perenjori Road Board to be the Vermin Board of the said Vermin District: And also to constitute that portion of the State comprised within the Morawa Road District as now constituted a Vermin District for the purposes of the said Act, under the name of the Morawa Vermin District, and to appoint the Morawa Road Board to be the Vermin Board of the said Vermin District: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, and of all other powers him enabling, doth hereby abolish the said Perenjori-Morawa Vermin District and dissolve the said Vermin Board thereof: And further, doth hereby constitute that portion of the State comprised within the Perenjori Road District as now constituted to be a Vermin District for the purposes of the said Act, under the name of the Perenjori Vermin District: And doth appoint the Board of the said Perenjori Road District to be the Board of the said Perenjori Vermin District: And further, doth hereby constitute that portion of the State comprised within the Morawa Road District as now constituted to be a Vermin District for the purposes of the said Act, under the name of the Morawa Vermin District: And doth appoint the Board of the said Morawa Road District to be the Board of the said Morawa Vermin District.

## Regulations.

M.R.B. 229/27; P.W. 939/26.

THE Regulations of a similar purport published in the *Government Gazette* on the 21st February, 1930, page 407, are hereby repealed and the following adopted in place thereof:—

The passage of any vehicle engaged in heavy traffic is prohibited on, over, or along any of the roads described in the Schedule hereunder during the months of June, July, August, and September in each and every year.

"Heavy traffic," for the purposes of this regulation, shall mean heavy traffic as defined in the regulation published in the *Government Gazette* on the 1st day of June, 1928, that is to say:—

"Heavy traffic" means and includes the traffic of all vehicles engaged in the carriage or conveyance of timber, or of sleepers, or other sawn, hewn, or split timber, firewood bricks, stone, gravel, metal, salt, lime, cement, farming produce, or other material in bulk, and the traffic of any vehicle the weight whereof (including load) exceeds twelve hundredweights per wheel.

Any person committing a breach of this regulation, either by act or omission, shall on conviction be liable to a penalty not exceeding Twenty pounds or to imprisonment for not exceeding one month.
