SUPREME COURT RULES, 1909.

Amendment of Rule 4, Order XXXVI.

13th October, 1930.

THE Honourable Sir Robert Furse McMillan, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Chief Justice of Western Australia; the Honourable John Alfred Northmore, the

Honourable Thomas Percy Draper, and the Honourable John Patrick Dwyer, Puisne Judges of the Supreme Court of Western Australia, in pursuance of the powers contained in "The Supreme Court Act, 1880," and of every other power them in this behalf enabling, to hereby amend Rule 4 of Order XXXVI. of the Rules of the Supreme Court, 1909, by the addition thereto of the following:—

"Such affidavits may also be sworn before a Justice of the Peace if no other authorised person is available within twenty miles of the deponent's residence or place of business. The certificate of such Justice in the jurat of the affidavit shall be a sufficient verification thereof."

And declare that the same shall come into effect on the publication thereof in the *Government Gazette*.
