- A Hawker's License shall be in the Form No. 3 in Schedule A attached hereto.
- 5. The fees to be paid for licenses issued to hawkers shall be as set forth in Schedule B attached hereto.
- Every application for a Hawker's License shall the made during the currency of the financial year in which the license is to have effect; and every such license shall have effect for and during that year, or the unexpired portion thereof, and no longer.
- Every hawker, while employed in hawking, must produce his license upon being required to do so by any police officer or officer of the Board.
- Every hawker shall rigidly affix to some conspicuous part of his eart, barrow, or other vehicle or basket, and at all times maintain thereon, a board or plate bearing his name and the words "Licensed Hawker" legibly written thereon, in letters not less than one inch in height and of corresponding width.
- 9. No person to whom a Hawker's License shall have been granted shall lend, transfer, or assign his license, and no person shall borrow or make use of such license granted to a person other than himself.
- 10. Any person who does, permits, or suffers any act, matter, or thing contrary to these By-laws, or commits or permits any breach or neglect thereof, shall be liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding £10 for every such conviction.

By-law No. 119.

- (1) All hoardings, signs, or notices within any Shopping Area, or on any shop, business, or place of industry within a Residential Area, or on any vacant land within the Municipality of Claremont, shall be obliterated, taken down, removed, or altered within a period of twelve months to conform to this By-law.
- (2) No shop, business, or place of industry shall creet or permit to remain erected or exhibited, any hoarding, sign, or other advertisement or notice, except the name of the owner or owners of the shop, business, or industry and the trade or calling carried on within the premises.
- (3) The size of such hoarding or sign exhibiting the name and calling of the owners shall not exceed the length of the front of the building in length and two feet in depth over all.
- (4) Such hoarding, sign, or notice shall not be put up or exhibited above any gutter line or parapet line on any structure, and its location shall be subject to the approval of the Council.

And no sign, notice, or intimation shall be put up until the approval of the Council shall have been signified in writing.

- (5) Subject to the provisions of the Municipal Corporations Act and the Town Planning and Development Act and these By-laws no hoarding, advertising device or structure of any kind shall be put up or erected within the area of the Municipality.
- (6) Except as herein provided, no person shall, near to any road, footway, or land under the control of the Claremont Municipality, put up any advertising device on any land, or upon any advertising hoarding or other hearding, wall, fence or other structure, or rock, stone, tree, or other thing, and in the case of a contravention of this By-law, if the person by whom the breach was actually committed is not known, then any person shown by the advertising device to be interested or benefited or capable of being interested or benefited by the put-ting up of the advertising device shall be deemed to have committed this breach.

Provided that the provisions of this By-law shall not apply to any notice or advertising device which a Local Authority by resolution declares to be of a national, charitable, or religious nature, and which notice or advertising device is removed immediately after the purpose for which it was put up shall have ceased to exist.
