The Land Act, 1898. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corr. No. 1150/20.

WHEREAS by Section 43 of "The Land Act, 1898," it is made lawful for the Governor in Council, without issuing any deed of grant, to place any Reserve under the control of any Municipality, Road Board, or other person or persons, as a Board of Management, and to empower such Board to make, repeal, and alter by-laws for the control and management of such Reserves, and prescribe fees for depasturing thereon, and for other purposes, such by-laws to be approved by the Governor and published in the Government Gazette: And whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve 20827 for Common at Mullewa should be placed under the control of the Mullewa Road Board as a Board of Management: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby place the before-mentioned Reserve under the control of the Mullewa Road Board as a Board of Management, and doth empower such Board to make, repeal, or alter by-laws for the control and management of the said Reserve; for prescribing fees for depasturing thereon; for directing the manner in which such fees shall be imposed, paid, collected, and disposed of, and to impose penalties not exceeding in any case £5 for any breach thereof, and £2 a day for a continuing breach, but not more than £20 in the aggregate.

On the expiration of every month every Insurance Company shall furnish the Commissioner of Stamps with separate returns, in writing, on a form to be approved by the Commissioner and verified by statutory declaration, of all policies, and all renewals of policies, of insurance effected by the company, and of the duty payable in respect of each policy and renewal. Such returns shall be accompanied by the amount of duty payable, for each policy and renewal be impressed by the Commissioner on the returns. The insurance company may indorse on the policy and renewal for the following words:—"£: Stamp duty paid to the Commissioner of Stamps under Regulation 6."

Interpretation.—In the construction of this By-law, unless the context otherwise requires—

- 1. "Beach" means any portion of the ocean or river foreshore within the boundaries of the Municipality of North Fremantle and that portion of Reserve 3729, held on lease from the Western Australian Government Railway Department.
- "Council" means the Council of the Municipality of North Fremantle.
- "Proper Bathing Costume" means a costume covering the body from the shoulders to the thighs, having an overpiece or skirt extending from the hips to a point half way between the hips and the knees, and which shall be composed of wool or wool and cotton mixtures.

 "Reserve" means any portion of the Reserve above-

mentioned including all buildings, erections and structures thereon.

- 1. No person shall create or commit any nuisance, or behave in a disorderly manner, or use indecent or improper language on the Reserve or upon the Beach.
- 2. No person shall climb on or over any building, shelter shed or lavatory, or climb on or over any fence or fixture erected on the Reserve or the Beach.
- 3. No person shall pry into or over or enter any layatory, bathing shed or building, or portion of a building, erected upon the Reserve or the Beach expressly reserved for the use of the opposite sex.
- 4. No person shall enter any portion of the Reserve or the Beach which has been fenced off or otherwise closed to the public.
- 5. No person shall break, injure, pull up, or destroy any tree, shrub or grass growing on the Reserve or the Beach.
- 6. No person shall cut, mutilate, deface, or disfigure any buildings, creations, fixtures, or structures upon the Beach or the Reserve, or, without the written consent of the Council, write, paste, or affix any notice or advertisement thereon.
- 7. No person shall expectorate or throw lighted matches upon any building, erection, or structure on the Reserve or the Beach.
- 8. No person shall place or break, or permit to be placed or broken, any glass, metal, bottle, or utensils on the Reserve or the Beach, and no person shall deposit or leave any rubbish, refuse, paper, broken glass, china or litter of any kind thereon except in receptacles provided for that purpose.
- 9. No person shall, without the written consent of the Council, remove any sand, soil or stone from the Reserve or the Beach.
- 10. No person shall, without the permission of the Council, allow any horse, cattle, sheep, donkey, mule, pig or other animal, or any fowl or other bird to enter or stray upon the Reserve or the Beach.
- 11. No person shall, either on the Reserve or the Beach, without the written consent of the Council—
 - (a) in any way damage, alter, or interfere with the electric light fittings or electrical equipment;
 - (b) sell or offer or expose for sale or hire any goods or merchandise;
 - (c) engage in any public speaking or in any musical, dramatic, or athletic performance;
 - (d) alter, deface, or remove from its position any notice board or other sign erected by the Council;
 - (e) take any intoxicating liquor on to any portion of the Beach or Reserve;
 - (f) carry or discharge any firearm or throw or discharge any stone or other missile.
- 12. No person shall cause or permit any dog of which he is the owner, as defined by Section 4 of "The Dog Act, 1903-28," or of which for the time being he has control, to be on that portion of the Beach situated between a point due West of Leighton Station and a point due west of Swan Street, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 9 p.m. daily. Any dog found on the Beach in contravention of this By-law may be destroyed.

- Every person on the Beach shall, when not attired in ordinary apparel, wear a proper bathing costune, and every person on any portion of the Reserve (other than the Beach), when not attired in ordinary apparel, shall wear, in addition to a proper bathing costume, a dressing gown or other garment of a similar nature which shall completely cover the body.
- 14. No person, without the written consent of the Council first had and obtained, shall camp or lodge at night in or occupy as sleeping quarters any stall, building, or structure of any kind crected on the Reserve
- Any person attempting to do any of the things expressly or impliedly forbidden in this By-law shall be liable to a punishment as if he had committed the offence.
- 16. Every person offending against any provision of this By-law shall be liable for every such offence to a penalty not exceeding £10.

IN THE COURT OF ARBITRATION OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

No. 54 of 1932.

IN the matter of an application to amend Industrial Agreement No. 11 of 1928, between the Western Australian Musicians' Industrial Union of Workers, Perth, Applicant, and the Entrepreneurs' Association Industrial Union of Employers of Western Australia, Respondent.

The 3rd day of March, 1932.

UPON hearing Mr. E. W. Walsh on behalf of the Applicant, and by consent, the Court doth hereby order and direct that Industrial Agreement No. 11 of 1928, dated the 28th day of March, 1928, declared a Common Rule, be and the same is hereby further amended as follows:—

By the addition of the following new Clause:—
Clause 4A.—Temporary Provisions as to playing an extra Instrument, Rehearsals, and switching over, or transferring an Orchestra to more than one Picture Show

- Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained, the following special provisions shall apply for the period commencing March 4th, 1932, and ending June 4th, 1932:-
 - (a) Playing an extra instrument.—Any musician may double or play an extra instrument during any night performance in a picture show, and the employer shall not be required to pay extra for of Industrial Agreement No. 11 of 1928 relating to playing an extra instrument, and Clause (f) of Industrial Agreement No. 11 of 1928 relating to playing an extra instrument shall be suspended during the currency of and the continuance of these temporary provisions.
 - (b) Special provisions as to rehearsals.—Subclause (B4) of Clause B, Subclause (H1, H2, H3, H4, H5) of Clause G, of Industrial Agreement No. 11 of 1928 are varied as follows:

The whole of the provisions relating to rehearsals and payment for same shall be suspended during the currency of and the continuance of these temporary provisions, and arrangements may be made between the employer and the orchestra for rehearsals between the hours of 9 o'clock a.m. and 11 o'clock a.m. on not more than three mornings in any one week, and such rehearsals shall be free.

- (c) Further, it shall be permissible for an employer carrying on business in more than one picture show to transfer or switch over the whole of his orchestra to a second picture theatre under his direct control and management, during any part of the time occupied for an evening performance, which shall not exceed three and onequarter of an hour for the both, and the employer shall not be permitted to transfer or switch over his band or orchestra to more than two of his picture theatres under his direct control and management during any evening session or performance.
- The foregoing provisions may be continued from month to month, after the said June 4th, 1932, by agreement between the parties, a memorandum of which, signed by or on behalf of the parties, shall be filed in the In the event of the parties failing to agree, the matter may be referred to the Court.
- (3.) The provisions of this amendment shall not affect or prejudice the right of any of the parties to the said Industrial Agreement to apply to the Court for a further amendment thereof, in pursuance of Section 90 of "The Industrial Arbitration Act, 1912-1925," or for a new award should occasion arise.
- (4.) Save as is herein expressly provided, and for the term or terms herein expressed or provided for, the said Industrial Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
