WHEREAS by Section 158 of "The Factories and Shops Act, 1920," it is enacted that the Governor may by Proclamation temporarily suspend the operations of the said Act, in so far as it applies to the closing times fixed or appointed for any shop or shops: And whereas it is expedient to exercise such power in manner herein-after appearing: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby by this Proclamation suspend the operations of the said Act on Wednesday, the 9th day of May, 1934, between the hours of 1 p.m. and 6 p.m., in so far as it applies to the closing time of all shops situated in the Wiluna Shop District.

FARMERS' DEBTS ADJUSTMENT ACT, 1930-33.

NOTICE is hereby given that the following Stay Order has been issued in accordance with Section 7, Subsection 1, of "The Farmers' Debts Adjustment Act, 1930-33," which reads as follows:—

A Stay Order shall direct that no action, execution, distress for rent, proceedings on default for breach of covenant under any mortgage or other security for money, or under an agreement for sale and purchase of land, or other process or proceeding, shall be commenced or proceeded with or put in force against the farmer or any of the farmer's assets, whether utilised in connection with or forming portion of the assets comprised in his farming business or not during the operation of such Stay Order. Provided that, by leave of a Judge, any action may, notwithstanding the Stay Order, be instituted and/or carried on against the farmer, but not beyond judgment.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LICENSING ACT, 1911  
(CONSOLIDATED),

and in the matter of a Petition for Authority to grant a new License.

To His Excellency, Sir James Mitchell, K.C.M.G.,  
Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Western Australia.

THE humble Petition of the undersigned sheweth as follows:—

1. That your Petitioners are a majority in number of the Electors living in an area comprised within a circle having a radius of sixty miles from the Post Office at Turkey Creek.
