TOWN PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT, 1928.

By-law No. 3.

Section 30 (1), Second Schedule, Clause 2.

By-laws for securing proper Sanitary and Hygienic conditions in connection with Buildings erected on lands liable to inundation.

(1) From and after the commencement of this By-law, no building intended for use as a dwelling-house, or for occupation by persons for any purpose whatsoever, shall be constructed upon any land which adjoins or is adjacent to any river, lake, or watercourse, unless such building is so constructed that the level of the lowest floor in such building is at least four feet above the highest recorded flood level of the waters of such river, lake, or watercourse at or near the locality of such building, so far as the same can be ascertained from the records of the Meteorological Bureau at Perth or from any other official records.

(2) This By-law shall apply and have effect throughout the State.

(3) The authority responsible for the carrying out of the preceding By-law shall be the Town Clerk or Secretary (as the case may be) to the local authority concerned, and also the Town Planning Commissioner.

(4) Any person who by act or omission commits a breach of the preceding By-law No. 3 commits an offence and shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £20.

IN THE COURT OF ARBITRATION OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

In the matter of "The Industrial Arbitration Act, 1912-1925," and in the matter of Part VII. of the said Act—Basic Wage.

IN pursuance of the provision of Part VII. of the above Act, the Court of Arbitration hereby determines and declares the Basic Wage to be paid to adult male and female workers shall be as follows:—

- (1) Metropolitan Area, which for this purpose shall be taken to be that portion of the State comprised within a radius of fifteen (15) miles from the General Post Office, Perth:—

Males £3 10s. 6d.
Females £1 18s. 1d.

- (2) Agricultural Areas, the South-West Land Division of the State, except such portion thereof as is comprised within the Metropolitan Area as defined herein:—

Males £3 11s. 2d.
Females £1 18s. 5d.

- (3) Goldfields Areas and all other portions of the State exclusive of the South-West Land Division:—

Males £4 4s. 4d.
Females £2 5s. 6d.

- (4) Payment shall be pro rata where the term of employment is for less than one (1) week.

THE TRAFFIC ACT, 1919-31.

Albany Road Board.

Traffic By-laws.

P.W. 149/24.

THE Albany Road Board, pursuant to an Order in Council, under Section 43 of "The Traffic Act, 1919-31," and in exercise of the power therein conferred, doth hereby make the following By-law, to have effect within the Albany Road District:—

The passage of any vehicle engaged in heavy traffic over the following roads, namely, Redmond Road, from Perth Road (Location 49) through Redmond to Hay River, Roads Nos. 1508, 1148, 5035, and Albany-Young's Siding Road, from railway crossing Albany through Elleker, Torbay, Kronkup, Bornholm to Main Road at Youngs, Roads Nos. 1682, 1160, 2605, 1185, 2984, 4690, is prohibited.

For the purpose of this By-law "Heavy traffic" means the traffic of all vehicles engaged in the carriage or conveyance of sleepers (sawn or hewn), split and other timber, firewood, bricks, stone, gravel, lime, cement, farm produce, or other material in bulk, and the traffic of any vehicle the weight thereof, including load, exceeds 15cwt. per wheel.

Any person who commits a breach of this By-law shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding £20.
