Saturday, 26th September, 1936—Kununoppin.

The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 828/34.
WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that the Governor may by Order in Council alter or extend the boundaries of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Area, or of any District: And whereas it is desirable that the boundaries of Metropolitan Stormwater Districts Nos. 2 and 1 as at present defined should be altered: Now, therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council,

do hereby alter the boundaries of Metropolitan Stormwater Districts Nos. 2 and 1 and declare that the said boundaries as shown on Plans M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A., Nos. 3449 and 2545, and as described in Order in Council of 18th June, 1919, and subsequent amendments, shall be altered in the following manner by deleting the area described hereunder from Metropolitan Stormwater District No. 1 and including it in Metropolitan Stormwater District No. 2:—

Schedule.

Commencing at a point in the centre of Slade street opposite the centre of the right-of-way at the rear of Lots 1 to 7 inclusive, South crescent, and proceeding in a south-westerly direction along the centre of the said right-of-way to the centre of Hamilton street; thence south-easterly along the centre of Hamilton street to a point opposite the south-east boundary of Lot 31, Hamilton street; thence south-westerly across Hamilton street and along the south-east boundaries of Lot 31, Hamilton street, and the right-of-way between Lots 35 and 36, King William street, to the centre of King William street; thence south-westerly across King William street and along the south-east boundary of Lot 19, King William street, to the centre of the right-of-way at the rear of the said Lot 19, King William street; thence north-westerly along the centre of the said right-of-way to a point opposite the centre of Glyde street; thence south-westerly along the centre of Glyde street to the centre of Georges street; thence north-westerly along the centre of Georges street to the centre of Murray street; thence north-easterly along the centre of Murray street to the centre of Veitch street; thence north-westerly along the centre of Veitch street to and across South crescent to the centre of the Railway Reserve; thence westerly along the centre of the Railway Reserve to a point opposite the south-west boundary of Lot 219, Railway crescent; thence north-westerly across the Railway Reserve to and across Railway crescent and along the south-west boundary of the said Lot 219, Railway crescent, to the centre of the right-of-way at the rear of Lot 219, Railway crescent; thence westerly along the centre of the said right-of-way to the centre of the right-of-way between The Strand and Shaftesbury avenue; thence north-westerly along the centre of the said right-of-way to and across Arundel street to a point opposite the north-west boundary of Lot 210, The Strand; thence north-easterly along the north-west boundary of the said Lot 210 to the centre of The Strand; thence south-easterly along the

centre of The Strand to the centre of Arundel street; thence north-easterly along the centre of Arundel street and along the north-west boundaries of Lots 17 to 5 inclusive, Copley street, to the north-east boundary of Lot 5, Copley street; thence south-easterly along the north-east boundary of the said Lot 5 to the centre of Copley street; thence north-easterly along the centre of Copley street to the centre of Drake street; thence south-easterly along the centre of Drake street to the centre of Burnside street; thence south-westerly along the centre of Burnside street to the centre of Coode street; thence south-easterly along the centre of Coode street to and across Railway crescent to the centre of the Railway Reserve; thence easterly along the centre of the Railway Reserve to a point opposite the centre of Slade street; thence south-easterly across the Railway Reserve to and across South crescent, and along the centre of Slade street to the point of commencement, as shown in red on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A., No. 3449.

Commencing at a point in the centre of Grant street opposite the centre of the first right-of-way west of Congdon street and proceeding east along the centre of Grant street to the centre of Congdon street; thence north along the centre of Congdon street to a point opposite the north boundary of Lot 17 of Location 95; thence east across Congdon street and along the north boundary of the said Lot 17 to the centre of the right-of-way between Congdon street and Parry street; thence north along the centre of the said right-of-way to the centre of Alexandra avenue; thence east along the centre of Alexandra avenue to the centre of Parry street; thence north along the centre of Parry street to a point opposite the north boundary of Lot 2, Parry street; thence east across Parry street and along the north boundary of the said Lot 2 to the centre of the right-of-way between Parry street and Grange street; thence north along the centre of the said right-of-way to the centre of the right-of-way between Kingsmill street and Stirling highway; thence east along the centre of the said right-of-way to the centre of Grange street; thence north along the centre of Grange street to a point opposite the north boundary of Lot 22, Grange street; thence east across Grange street and along the north boundary of the said Lot 22 to the centre of the right-of-way between Grange street and Albert street; thence north along the centre of the said right-of-way to a point opposite the north boundary of Lot 3, Albert street; thence east across the said right-of-way and along the north boundary of the said Lot 3 to the centre of Albert street; thence north along the centre of Albert street to a point opposite the north boundary of Lot 8, Albert street; thence east across Albert street and along the north boundary of the said Lot 8 to the west boundary of Lot 18, Stirling highway; thence north along the west boundary of the said Lot 18 to its north-west corner; thence east along the north boundary of the said Lot 18 to its north-east corner; thence south along the east boundary of the said Lot 18 to the north boundary of Lot 9, Dean street; thence east along the north boundary of the said Lot 9

to the centre of Dean street; thence north along the centre of Dean street to a point opposite the north boundary of Lot 4, Dean street; thence east across Dean street and along the north boundary of the said Lot 4 to the south-west corner of Lot 53, Mount street; thence north along the west boundary of the said Lot 53 to the centre of the right-of-way between Barnfield road and Mount street; thence east along the centre of the said right-of-way to a point in the centre of the right-of-way between Dean street and Stirling road; thence south along the centre of the said right-of-way to a point opposite the north boundary of Lot 40, Stirling road; thence east across the said right-of-way and along the north boundary of the said Lot 40 to and across Stirling road to the centre of O'Beirne street; thence easterly along the centre of O'Beirne street to a point opposite the first right-of-way east of Stirling road; thence southerly across O'Beirne street and along the centre of the said right-of-way to the centre of the right-of-way between O'Beirne street and St. Quentin avenue; thence easterly along the centre of the said right-of-way to the west boundary of Lot 90, St. Quentin avenue; thence northerly along the west boundary of the said Lot 90 for a distance of approximately 127 links; thence easterly across Lots 90 and 91, St. Quentin avenue, to a point on the east boundary of Lot 91, 269 links from the north side of St. Quentin avenue; thence southerly along the east boundary of the said Lot 91 to and across St. Quentin avenue and along the east boundary of Lot 78, Stirling highway, for a distance of approximately 215 links; thence westerly across Lots 78 and 79, Stirling highway, and along the north boundaries of Lots 1 and 2 of Lot 80, Stirling highway, to the north-east corner of Lot 3 of Lot 81, Stirling highway; thence southerly along the east boundary of the said Lot 3 to and across Stirling highway, and along the east boundaries of Lots 1 and 2, Queenslea drive, to the south-east corner of Lot 2, Queenslea drive; thence westerly along the south boundary of the said Lot 2 to the east side of Queenslea drive; thence south along the east side of Queenslea drive to the south-west corner of Lot 72, Queenslea drive; thence west across Queenslea drive to the east boundary of Location 616; thence south along the east boundaries of the said Location 616 and Location 718 to the foreshore; thence westerly along the said foreshore to the south-east corner of Lot 63, Richardson avenue; thence westerly along the south boundary of the said Lot 63 to the centre of Richardson avenue; thence southerly along the centre of Richardson avenue to the centre of Wilson street; thence westerly along the centre of Wilson street to a point opposite the west boundary of Lot 31, Wilson street; thence north across Wilson street and along the west boundary of the said Lot 31 to its north-west corner; thence east along the north boundary of the said Lot 31 to the south-west corner of Lot 42, Prospect place; thence north along the west boundary of the said Lot 42 to its north-west corner; thence north-easterly along the north-west side of Prospect place to the south-west boundary of Lot 41, Prospect place; thence north-westerly along the south-west boundary of the said Lot 41 to the south-east side of Stirling highway; thence northerly across Stirling highway and along the east side of Congdon street to a point opposite the south boundary of Lot 4, Congdon street, a distance of approximately 297 links; thence west across Congdon street and along the south boundary of the said Lot 4 to the centre of the first right-of-way west of Congdon street; thence north along the centre of the said right-of-way to the point of commencement, as shown in blue on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A., No. 4105.

FARMERS' DEBTS ADJUSTMENT ACT, 1930-1934.
