WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend water works, sewerage works, and stormwater drainage works: And whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lientenant-Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely: works under the said Act, namely:-

Metropolitan Sewerage, Perth District—Forrest place; Main Sewer:—15-inch diameter cement-lined cast-iron pipe sewer and a 12-inch diameter reinforced concrete pipe sewer, with all manholes and other apparatus connected therewith, as shown in red on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A., No. 5951.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 8th day of October, 1937.

FARMERS' DEBTS ADJUSTMENT ACT, 1930-1934.

NOTICE is hereby given that the following Stay Orders have been issued in accordance with Section 7, Subsection 1, of "The Farmers' Debts Adjustment Act, 1930-1934," which reads as follows:—
