HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 319 of the Health Act, 1911-1942, has been pleased to make the regulations set forth in the schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

HEALTH ACT, 1911-1942.

Venereal Diseases Regulations.

1. The notice to be given by the Commissioner pursuant to subsection (1) of section 279 of the Act to any person believed or suspected to be suffering from venereal disease shall be according to the form numbered (1) in the appendix to these regulations.

2. Whenever by reason of the non-production of the required certificate or, if produced, of the unsatisfactory nature thereof, the Commissioner shall consider that the circumstances of the case require the issue of his warrant for the compulsory examination of such person, such warrant shall issue in the form numbered (2) in the appendix to these regulations.

3. Notice of the date, time and place of the compulsory examination referred to in the preceding regulation shall be given by post or by leaving such notice at the last known place of abode of the suspected person. If the suspected person fails to attend for examination in accordance with the requirements of such notice, the Commissioner may issue a warrant in the form numbered (3) in the appendix for the apprehension of the suspected person for the purpose of examination aforesaid.

4. If, in the opinion of the Commissioner, a report of examination is such as, in accordance with the provisions of subsection (2) of section 279 of the Act, justifies the apprehension and detention of the person named in such report, the Commissioner may issue his warrant accordingly and such warrant shall be in the form numbered (4) in the appendix to these regulations.

5. The Commissioner may, whenever the circumstances of the case so require, issue his warrant in the form numbered (5) in the appendix to these regulations for the apprehension, if necessary, and further detention of any person suffering from venereal diseases in an infectious condition.

6. Insofar as the apprehension of any person is concerned, every such warrant as is mentioned in these regulations shall be directed to all police officers in the State of Western Australia and to such officer or officers of the Department of Public Health as the Commissioner shall think fit and shall be sufficient authority for any such police or other officer forthwith to apprehend the person named therein and to convey him to the place of detention specified and for the detention of such person in such place of detention for the period specified in such warrant.

7. Every warrant issued under these regulations shall have effect according to its tenor and all police officers and officers of the Department of Public Health and all governing authorities and officers of any hospital or place in which any person is detained under these regulations shall do all things necessary to carry into effect the provisions of these regulations.

8. These regulations may be cited as the Health (Venereal Diseases) Regulations, 1943, and shall come into operation on the date of their publication in the *Government Gazette*.

REQUEST FOR MEDICAL CERTIFICATE.

TAKE NOTICE that, having reason to believe (or having reasonable grounds to suspect) that you are a person suffering from venereal disease, I hereby require you to consult a medical practitioner and to produce to my satisfaction within days of the service upon you of this notice a certificate under the hand of such medical practitioner that you are (or are not) suffering from venereal disease. AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that if such certificate is not produced within the time stated or, if produced, is not to my satisfaction, a warrant for your compulsory examination may issue.

WHEREAS on the day of 19 , a warrant for the compulsory examination pursuant to regulation 2 of the Health (Venereal Diseases) Regulations, of a person believed or suspected to be suffering from venereal disease was issued but such person failed to attend at the appointed time and place as required by notice, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by regulation 3 I do therefore order you the said Police Officers and Inspectors forthwith to apprehend the said and convey him (or her) to for the purpose of examination in accordance with the terms of the warrant aforesaid.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by section 279 of the Health Act, 1911-1942, I do therefore order you the said Police Officers and Inspectors forthwith to apprehend the said _____ and convey him (or her) to the _____ Hospital at _____ (or to convey the said _____ from the hospital or other place of which he is now an inmate to the gaol hospital at _____) and deliver him to the officer in charge thereof. AND WHEREAS the period of detention stated in the said warrant having expired it appears to me that the said _____ is suffering from venereal disease in an infectious condition and that it is necessary in the interests of the public further to detain the said _____ (or WHEREAS the said _____ has absconded from the place of detention aforesaid) I THEREFORE AUTHORISE AND REQUIRE you the said Police Officers and Inspectors forthwith to apprehend the said _____ and convey him (or her) to the _____ hospital at _____ and deliver him (or her) to the officer in charge thereof and I AUTHORISE AND REQUIRE you the said Officer in Charge of the said _____ hospital to receive the said _____ into your care and to detain the said _____ for the further period of _____ weeks or until his (or her) discharge shall be sooner ordered.

MUNICIPALITY OF KALGOORLIE.

The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1941.

Amendment of By-laws—Control of Dogs.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by the said Act, the Municipality of Kalgoorlie hereby orders as follows:—By-law No. 135:—No owner or keeper of any dog or dogs shall permit the same upon any street, road, right-of-way within that portion of the Municipality bounded by the south side of Brookman street, the west side of Porter street, the north side of Egan street and the east side of Wilson street at any time or times unless the same are under proper control of the keeper thereof, and upon a leash attached to the collar around the dog's neck and held by the owner or keeper thereof at all times whilst such dog is permitted to be within the boundaries mentioned within the Municipality. All straying dogs found unattended and not under proper control of the owners or keepers thereof upon the roads, streets, right-of-ways within that portion of the Municipality mentioned may be collected and destroyed, in

addition to which the owners or keepers thereof are liable to a penalty not exceeding Ten Pounds (£10).

Adopted by the Municipality of Kalgoorlie, this fourth day of October, 1943.
