PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency Sir James Mitchell,
TO WIT. } K.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Governor in and
JAMES MITCHELL, } over the State of Western Australia
Lieutenant-Governor. } and its Dependencies in the Common-

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Cemeteries Act, 1897, and its amendments, it is made lawful for the Governor in Executive Council from time to time by Proclamation to appoint such place or places in each district as shall be deemed expedient to be reserved for the burial of the dead: Now, therefore, I Sir James Mitchell, Lieutenant-Governor of the said State, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in exercise of the powers in me vested as aforesaid, do by this my Proclamation appoint reserve No. 9954 (Avon Locations 16466 and 17988), at Woorooloo, as a Public Cemetery under the provisions of the said Act, but subject always to such regulations as may be published from time to time for the proper management of the same.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State at Perth, this 21st day of February, 1945.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chambers at Perth, on the 21st day of February, 1945, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

The Water Boards Act, 1904-1937.

Moora Water Board.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 36/41.

WHEREAS by section 40 of the Water Boards Act, 1904-1937, it is enacted that subject to the provisions of the said Act a Water Board shall have power to construct water works for the purposes of the said

Act; and whereas it is provided by section 41 of the said Act (as amended by the Water Boards Act Amendment Act, 1937), that the Governor may exempt reticulation works from the operation of certain sections of the said Act; and whereas it is deemed expedient that reticulation works not exceeding 4 inches in diameter and not exceeding a cost of £200 in relation to such reticulation work to be constructed hereafter by the Moora Water Board shall be exempted from the operation of the said sections of the said Act: Now therefore His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, and of all other powers in this behalf enabling him doth hereby exempt from the operations of sections 41, 42, 43, 44 and 45 of the Water Boards Act, 1904-1937, all reticulation works not exceeding 4 inches in diameter and not exceeding a cost of £200 in relation to such reticulation work which the Moora Water Board may hereafter from time to time find it necessary to carry out, either alone or in connection with other water works in the course of exercising the powers conferred upon the said Water Boards by section 40 of the said Act.

Local Authorities (Reserve Funds) Act, 1942.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 404/43.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 4 of the Local Authorities (Reserve Funds) Act, 1942, that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Honorary Minister but subject to the requirements of the proviso to the said section, by Order in Council, authorise a local authority to establish during the present war and to maintain a reserve fund for the purpose of accumulating therein any surplus of ordinary revenue of the Local Authority and of applying the moneys in such reserve fund and any income or profit derived from the investment of moneys in such reserve fund in the carrying out, after the cessation of the present war, of works and undertakings authorised by the Local Government Act of the Local Authority which the Local Authority may not be able conveniently to

carry out during the present war; and whereas it is desirable that such reserve fund shall be established by the Local Authorities as set forth in the Schedule hereto: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, acting pursuant to the recommendation of the Honorary Minister and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the power conferred by the said Act, after being satisfied as required by the proviso to section 4 of the said Act, doth hereby authorise the Local Author-

ities as set forth in the Schedule hereto, to establish and maintain a reserve fund.

WHEREAS by Instrument of Delegation dated the seventh day of May, 1942, made in pursuance of section 17 of the National Security Act, 1939-1940, the Minister of State for Defence delegated to every officer who should at any time during the continuance of the delegation be holding the office or performing the duties of the office of Commander of a Lines of Communication Area the powers and functions conferred upon the said Minister by regulation 4 of the National Security (General) Regulations in relation to that Lines of Communication Area; and whereas on the seventh day of December, 1942, Oswald Vick Hoad, Brigadier, the Officer then holding the office of Commander of Western Australia Lines of Communication Area, acting in pursuance of the said Instrument of Delegation and the said regulation, made an order under the said regulation in relation to the land referred to in the schedule thereto and hereto; and whereas by Instrument of Delegation dated the fourth day of December, 1944, made in pursuance of section 17 of the National Security Act, 1939-1940, the Acting Minister of State for the Army acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for Defence delegated to every officer who should at any time during the continuance of the delegation be holding the office or performing the duties of the office of Commander Western Command the powers and functions conferred upon the said Minister by regulation 4 of the National Security (General) Regulation in relation to the State of Western Australia exclusive of that area situate northward of the straight line joining Yampi Sound and the intersection of twenty degrees south latitude with the Western boundary of the Northern Territory: Now therefore I, Horace Clement Hugh Robertson, Major-General, the officer for the time being holding the office of Commander Western Command, acting in pursuance of the said lastmentioned Instrument of Delegation and of the said regulation and of all other powers me hereunto enabling do hereby revoke the said order dated the 7th day of December, 1942.

All that portion of Swan Bank road (Road No. 6330) passing along the western boundaries of lots 537 and 536 of Swan Location 2039, and part of the western boundary of lot 534 from the southern side of a drain reserve at the northern corner of the first-mentioned lot to an angle in the road boundary of the lastmentioned lot situate 87.8 links from its north-western corner.

ORDER UNDER REGULATION 4 OF THE NATIONAL SECURITY (GENERAL) REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS by regulation 4 of the National Security (General) Regulations it is provided (amongst other things) that if it appears to the Minister to be necessary or expedient in the interests of the defence of the Commonwealth or the efficient prosecution of the war, or for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community that special precautions should be taken for the security of any place, he may by order declare that place to be a prohibited place either generally or during such hours or during the existence of such circumstances as are specified in the order for the purposes of the regulations; and whereas on the twentieth day of December, 1943, Oswald Vick Hoad, Brigadier, the officer for the time being holding the office of Commander of Western Australia Lines of Communication Area, acting in pursuance of an Instrument of Delegation dated twenty-first day of September, 1943, made in pursuance of section 17 of the National Security Act, 1939-1940, by the Minister of State for the Army, acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for Defence and in pursuance of the said regulation 4 and on all other powers him thereunto enabling, made an order under the said regulation 4 relating to the places described in the schedule thereto being places then situate within the said Western Australia Lines of Communication Area and now situate within that portion of the State of Western Australia as hereafter limited; and whereas by Instrument of Delegation dated the fourth day of December, 1944, made in pursuance of section 17 of the National Security Act, 1939-1940, the Acting Minister of State for the Army acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for Defence delegated to every officer who should at any time during the continuance of the delegation be holding the office or performing the duties of the office of Commander Western Command the powers and functions conferred upon the said Minister by regulation 4 of the National Security (General) Regulations in relation to the State of Western Australia exclusive of that Area situate northward of the straight line joining Yampi Sound and the intersection of twenty degrees south latitude with the Western boundary of the Northern Territory; and whereas it appears to me, Horace Clement Hugh Robertson, Major-General, the officer for the time being holding the office of Commander Western Command, necessary and expedient in the interest of the defence of the Commonwealth and the efficient prosecution of the war and for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community that special precautions should be taken for the security of the places referred to in the Schedule hereto, being places situate within that portion of the State of Western Australia as above limited: Now therefore I, the said Horace Clement Hugh Robertson, acting in pursuance of the said Instrument of Delegation dated the fourth day of December, 1944, and of the said regulation 4 and of all other powers me hereunto enabling:—

1. Do hereby revoke the said order made by the said Oswald Vick Hoad dated the twentieth day of December, 1943.

2. Do hereby order: (a) That the places described in the Schedule hereto are declared to be prohibited places generally for the purpose of the National Security (General) Regulations from the date of the making of this order.

(b) That WX1582 T/Major Roger Francis Berkeley Fitzhardinge, S.O.R.A. II, R.A.A., Fremantle Fortress, and NX70379 Major Colin Charles Marr, G. II, Int., Western Command, are authorised to issue permits to enter, approach, inspect, pass over, or be in the neighbourhood of the said prohibited places.

The Schedule.

(a) All that area of land situate near the Western Australian coast off Fremantle in the State of Western Australia and known as Carnac Island and all that area of sea surrounding the said Carnac Island to a distance of one and a-half miles from every part of the coastline thereof.

(b) All that area of land situate near the Western Australian coast off Fremantle in the State of Western Australia and known as Garden Island and all that area of sea surrounding the said Garden Island to a distance of one mile from every part of the coastline thereof.

(c) All that area of land and sea situate to the west of Rockingham in the State of Western Australia and contained within the following boundaries:—Commencing at a point on the coastline as defined at low water mark in Mangles Bay at a distance of 60 chains west of the Peron House Jetty and proceeding thence on a bearing of 206° to cut the coastline as defined at low water mark in Shoalwater Bay, thence due south-west 8,000 links, thence following the coastline and at a constant distance of 8,000 links therefrom round Cape Peron to a point due north of and distant 8,000 links from the point of commencement, thence due south to the point of commencement.

FARMERS' DEBTS ADJUSTMENT ACT, 1930-1934.

NOTICE is hereby given that the following Stay Order has been issued in accordance with section 7, subsection 1 of the Farmers' Debts Adjustment Act, 1930-1934, which reads as follows:—

A Stay Order shall direct that no action, execution, distress for rent, proceedings on default for breach of covenant under any mortgage or other security for money, or under an agreement for sale and purchase of lands, or other process of proceedings, shall be commenced or proceeded with or put in force against the farmer, or any of the farmer's assets whether utilised in connection with or forming portion of the assets comprised in his farming business or not during

the operation of such Stay Order; provided that by leave of a judge any action may, notwithstanding the Stay Order, be instituted and/or carried on against the farmer but not beyond judgment.

NOMINATIONS of persons to be their representatives on the Board are hereby called from registered general trained nurses, registered mental nurses, and registered midwifery nurses, and must be in the hands of the Commissioner of Public Health, Department of Public Health, Perth, at midday, Thursday, the 29th March, 1945. Every nomination shall be in writing, shall contain the name in full and address of the person nominated, shall be signed by at least two registered nurses of the appropriate category, and be accompanied by the written consent of the person nominated to serve on the Board.

MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS ACT, 1906-1943.

Municipality of Geraldton—Amendment to By-laws.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by the said Act the Mayor and Councillors of the Municipality of Geraldton order as follows:—

(1) Clauses 4 and 4A of by-law No. 11 of the by-laws of the Municipality of Geraldton published in the *Government Gazette* on the 14th day of February, 1930, as amended by the by-law published in the *Government Gazette* of the 17th day of April, 1931, are hereby repealed and the following clauses are inserted in the said by-law No. 11 between clauses 3 and 5 in lieu thereof:—

4. The Council appoints the following stands for motor vehicles other than those plying for hire:—

(a) Marine terrace—On the northerly side, from Durlacher street to the easterly end of Marine terrace.

(b) Marine terrace—On the northerly side, from Gregory street to Fitzgerald street.

(c) Marine terrace—On the southerly side, from Gregory street to Fitzgerald street.

(d) Cathedral avenue—On the easterly side, from Marine terrace to Sanford street.

(e) Fitzgerald street—On the westerly side, from Marine terrace to Sanford street.

The stands appointed by this clause shall not include those portions of the street which are within 30 feet of an intersection or junction with another street.

4A. No person in charge of any vehicle shall cause or permit such vehicle to stand on the southerly side of Marine terrace between Post Office lane and the westerly boundary of the Geraldton Post Office land unless he does so in the course of a duty or engagement as an employee of or contractor with the Post Master General's Department.

4B. No person in charge of any vehicle shall cause or permit such vehicle to stand on any portion of Marine terrace, other than portion of a stand appointed by this by-law, for a longer period than 30 minutes between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any Friday.

4C. No person in charge of any vehicle shall cause or permit such vehicle to stand in a street whether on a stand appointed by this by-law or otherwise, in such a position as to obstruct the entrance to any lane or right-of-way or to obstruct the passage of vehicles to or from any premises by way of an entrance way provided for the purpose.

Amending Statute No. 1 of 1945.

Amendment to Statute No. 20—Guild of Undergraduates.

Section 4 to be amended to read as follows:—

All matriculated and unmatriculated students proceeding to a degree or diploma, or enrolled in one full unit, in the University, shall be members of the Guild. No other person shall be a member of the Guild.

Section 8 to be amended to read as follows:—

8. (a) The annual subscription to the Guild shall be—(i) for members who are internal students the sum of three guineas; (ii) for members who are external students the sum of ten shillings and sixpence; (iii) for associate members and associates such sums not in excess of two guineas as may be prescribed in the Regulations.

(b) A registration fee of one guinea shall be charged to all internal students upon first admission to the University.
