IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of the Bank Holidays Act, 1884, I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the said State, do by this my Proclamation appoint Thursday, 13th September, 1945, a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday in the Town of Carnamah.

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Sir James Mitchell, TO WIT. K.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Governor in and over the State of Western Australia Lieutenant-Governor. [L.S.] wealth of Australias

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 5 of the Road Districts Act, 1919-1943, that for the purposes of the said Act, the word "Town" or "Townsite" means and includes inter alia any land (including privately owned subdivided land) which the Governor may see fit, as he is hereby empowered, to declare by Proclamation to be a Town or Townsite for the purposes of the said Act; and whereas all that land situate within the Perth Road District, and more particularly described defined, and delineated in the Schedule described, defined, and delineated in the Schedule hereto, is land which the Governor may by virtue of section 5 of the said Act declare by Proclamation to be a Town or Townsite for the purposes of the said Act: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor,

acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the power conferred upon me by the said Act, and for all other powers in this behalf enabling me, do hereby declare that all that land situate within the Perth Road District, and more particularly described, defined and delineated in the Schedule hereto shall be a Townsite, to be known as "Hamersley" within the meaning and for the purpose of the Road Districts Act, 1919-

Bounded on the north and west by parts of the district boundary from its intersection with the western side of Wanneroo road (road No. 3) to its intersection with the production west of the south boundary of Swan Location 611; on the southward and eastward by lines commencing at the last-mentioned intersection, and extending east and north along said production and the south boundary of location 611 and part of its east boundary, east and south along the north and east boundaries of location 1153, east along the north boundary of location 1154, and south about 2 chains 75 links along part of its east boundary; thence east and south along a north and the east boundary of late 7/1372 to a point one chain west of the north-west corner of location 959, east to and along the north boundary of the last-mentioned location, and onward to a west boundary of Perthshire Location A t, north and east along part of said west and the north boundary of same, north and east along an east and a south boundary of Swan Location 92 and the south boundaries of locations 592 and 3134 (reserve 18476); thence north-westward and northward along a north-western and a western side of Wanneroo road (road No. 3) to its intersection with the district boundary.

WHEREAS under the provisions of section 4 of the Mining Tenements (War Time Exemption) Act, 1942, it is enacted that during a time of war the Governor may by Proclamation, for the period mentioned in such Proclamation, waive or postpone the payment of rent on any mining tenement which is prescribed and payable under the Mining Act, 1904-1937, and exempt the holder of any mining tenement from his obligation under the Mining Act, 1904-1937 to observe comply with or per-Mining Act, 1904-1937, to observe, comply with or perform any conditions relating to such mining tenement; and whereas a time of war now exists to wit the War in which His Majesty is now engaged with Germany, Italy, and Japan (hereinafter referred to as "the present war") and it is desirable to give effect to the said section 4 in relation to certain mining tenements during the present war: Now, therefore I, Sir James Mitchell, Lieutenant-Governor as aforesaid, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do by this Proclamation direct in relation to the mining tenements set out in the Schedule hereunder and for the period stated in the said Schedule that the payment of rent shall be waived and the holders of the mining tenements mentioned in the said Schedule shall be exempted from compliance with the labour covenants relating to such mining tenements.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council, held in the Executive Council Chambers, at Perth, this 18th day of July, 1945, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:

Health Act, 1911-1944.

Alteration of Boundaries of Swan Health District.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 19 of the Health Act, 1911-1944, that the Governor may by Order in Council constitute any portion of the State, not being a municipal district, a health district, with such boundaries and by such name as may be specified in the order, and may alter the boundaries of any such district; and whereas the Swan health district has been duly constituted with the boundaries thereof varied from time to time as notified by Orders in Council published in the Government Gazette on the 8th July, 1938, the 5th August, 1938, and the 23rd September, 1938, respectively; and whereas it is now deemed expedient further to alter the boundaries of the said Swan health district: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act doth hereby alter the boundaries of the said Swan health district in such manner that henceforth the said district shall comprise all those portions of the State more particularly described defined and delineated in the Schedule hereunder.

The whole of the land comprised in lots 188, 189 and 190 of Swan Location 16, as shown on L.T.O. Dia-

gram No. 4826.

B. All that portion of land, bounded by lines starting from the intersection of the northern side of Widgee road, with the prolongation northerly of the eastern boundary of lot 9 of Swan Locations M and M1, and extending easterly along the said side of road, to the eastern side of Bennett street; thence southerly along eastern side of Bennett street; thence southerly along the said side to the southern boundary of location L; thence easterly, along the said boundary, to the western side of Arthur street; thence northerly, along the said side, to the northern side of Patricia street; thence easterly, along the said side, to the south-western corner of lot 80 of the said location L; thence northerly, and easterly, along boundaries of the said lot, to the south-western corner of lot 78; thence northerly, along the western boundary of the said lot, and onwards, to the northern boundary to the right hank of the Swan River. the said boundary to the right bank of the Swan River; thence generally south-easterly, downwards, along the said bank, to a point opposite the junction of the left bank of the said river with the right bank of Jane bank of the said river with the right bank of Jane brook, thence generally northerly, and south-easterly, upwards, to and along the said right bank of the brook, to its intersection with the southern boundary of location 12; thence easterly, along the said boundary to a north-western corner of location 1114; thence, following the boundaries of the Swan Road District, generally south-westerly, south-easterly, south-westerly, north-westerly, south-westerly and north-westerly, to the left bank of the Swan river aforesaid; thence north-easterly upwards, along the said bank, to the northern corner of location 22; thence south-easterly, along the north-eastern boundary of the said location, to a point situate in prolongation south-westerly of the south-eastern boundary of location 1843; thence north-easterly, to and along the said boundary, and onwards to the south-western boundary of Helena Location 20; thence south-easterly, northdary of Helena Location 20; thence south-easterly, northcasterly, and north-westerly, along boundaries of the said location, and onwards to the left bank of the Helena river; thence generally north-easterly, upwards, along the said bank, to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the northern side of Terrace road, Guildford; thence westerly, along the said prolongation, to the western corner of lot 181 of Swan location 16; thence north-easterly, along the south-eastern boundary of the Eastern Railway reserve to the south-western boundary of lot Railway reserve, to the south-eastern boundary of the Eastern Railway reserve, to the south-western boundary of lot 178; thence south-easterly, generally north-easterly, and north-westerly, along boundaries of the said lot, to the said boundary of the Railway reserve; thence north-easterly, along the said boundary, to its junction with the north-eastern side of High street; thence south-easterly, covers and the said boundary agrees. easterly, across Amherst road and the said Railway reserve, to a survey post on the north-western boundary

of the latter reserve; thence north, to the left bank of the Swan river aforesaid; thence westerly, and south-westerly, downwards, along the said bank, to again join the boundaries of the Swan Road District aforesaid; and thence generally north-westerly, following the said boundaries, to the starting point.
