WHEREAS it is enacted by section 25 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Act, 1910-1937, as reprinted under the Amendments Incorporation Act, 1938, that the Governor may by Proclamation declare any article to be a poison within the meaning of the said Act, and may revoke or vary any Proclamation made under the said section by a subsequent Proclamation; and whereas the Governor has under and in accordance with the said section from time to time proclaimed certain articles to be poisons as aforesaid; and whereas it is now deemed desirable and expedient to add to such poisons declared as aforesaid: Now therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the power conferred upon me in that behalf by section 25 of the said Act do hereby declare that the article specified in the Schedule hereunder shall be deemed a poison within the meaning of the Pharmacy and Poisons Act, 1910-1937, and that the name thereof shall be inserted under the appropriate Schedules to the said Act.

When above the strength of 5 per cent. to be inserted in part 1 of the Fifth Schedule.

When above the strength of 2 per cent. and not

over 5 per cent. to be inserted in part 2 of the Fifth Schedule.

When above the strength of 0.5 per cent., and not above 2 per cent. to be inserted in the Ninth Schedule. In weaker strengths it must not be labelled "non poisonous."

The description of the article declared aforesaid is as follows:—"Dichlorodiphenyltrichloroethene, commonly known as D.D.T."

#### Melville Road Board-Resolution.

WHEREAS under the provisions of section 321 of the WHEREAS under the provisions of section 321 of the Health Act, 1911-1944, the Governor may cause to be prepared Model By-laws, for all or any of the purposes for which by-laws may be made, by a local authority under any of the provisions of the Act; and whereas a local authority may of its own motion by resolution adopt the whole or any portion of such by-laws with or without modification; and whereas Model By-laws

described as Series A have been prepared in accordance with the said section and published in the Government Gazette on the 8th day of April, 1927, and amended by notice published in the Government Gazette from time to time thereafter; and whereas the said Model By-laws have been reprinted with amendments and published in the Government Gazette of the 4th December, 1944: Now, therefore, the Melville Road Board being a local health authority within the meaning of the Act doth hereby resolve and determine that the said Model Bylaws as reprinted in the Government Gazette of the 4th laws as reprinted in the Government Gasette of the 4th December, 1944, shall be adopted with the following additions and amendments:

Regulation 4A of Part I. of the By-laws is amended

by adding thereto a paragraph as follows:—
(3) Laundries facilities shall be contained in a (3) Laundries facilities shall be contained in a building constructed, as to the walls thereof, with brick, concrete, or wood and iron, and, as to the roof, with tiles, corrugated galvanised iron or other impervious material provided with spouting and downpiping. The floor of such building shall be constructed of concrete 4 inches thick rendered to a smooth surface with 2 to 1 cement mortar and graded 1 in 20 and shall have an area of not less than 50 square feet. The walls of such building shall be not less than 8 feet high from the floor level.

2. An additional by-law to be known as by-law 26 to be inserted after by-law 25 in Part IV. of the By-laws

as follows:

It shall not be lawful to establish or commence any dairy within any part or portion of the Melville Road District except within that area of land within the following boundary lines that is to say starting from a point at the intersection of Stock and Bulls Creek roads; thence easterly to a point where the prolongation of the eastern boundary of Rome road intersects; thence northerly along Rome road to the southern boundary of Kitchener road; thence easterly along Kitchener road and a prolongation of this line, to a point where it meets Melville parade; thence southers the southern than the southern the southern than the southern the southern than the southe erly along the western boundary of Melville parade and a prolongation of this line to a point where it and a prolongation of this line to a point where it intersects Bulls Creek road; thence easterly along Bulls Creek; thence following the northern, eastern, southern and western boundaries of the Country Ward to the starting point.
3. An additional by-law to be known as by-law 20

to be inserted after by-law 19 in Part IX. of the By-laws

as follows:

20. It shall not be lawful to establish in any part or portion of the Melville Road Board District any of the trades, businesses, or occupations usually carried on, in, or connected with the undermentioned works or establishments, that is to say:—Abattoirs or slaughter-houses; bone mills or bone manure depots; chemical works; fat rendering establishments; fell moneraries to previous or wool-scouring establishments. chemical works; fat rendering establishments; fell mongeries, tanneries, or wool-scouring establishments; glue factories; marine stores; places for storing, drying or preserving bones, hides, hoofs, or skins; tripeboiling establishments; works for boiling down meat, bones, blood or offal, or any trade, business, process, or manufacture whatsoever causing effluvia, offensive fumes, vapours or gases, or discharging dust, foul liquid, blood, or other impurity (excepting piggeries and fish shops); and the establishment of any such trade, business, or occupation is strictly prohibited in any portion of the Board's district.

# Amendment of Regulations.

# 38.—Sick Leave.

(a) (1) A worker shall be entitled to payment for non-attendance on the ground of personal ill health for one-half (½) day for each completed month of service.

(2) The liability of the employer shall in no case exceed one (1) week's wages during each calendar year in respect of each worker.

in respect of each worker.

Payment hereunder may be adjusted at the end of each calendar year, or at the time the worker leaves the service of the employer, in the event of the worker

being entitled by service subsequent to the sickness to a greater allowance than that made at the time the sickness occurred.

(b) The clause shall not apply where the worker is entitled to compensation under the Workers' Compensa-

tion Act, 1912-1944.

(c) No worker shall be entitled to the benefit of this clause unless he produces proof satisfactory to his employer or his representative of sickness but the employer shall not be entitled to a medical certificate unless the absence is for three consecutive working days or more.

(d) No payment shall be made for any absence due

to the worker's own fault, neglect or misconduct.

(e) (1) Periods of service of less than one month shall not be included as service for the computation of sick leave.

(2) Periods of one month and over shall be totalled and payment for sick leave computed on the total of such service during the year.
