WHEREAS under the provisions of section 4 of the Mining Tenements (War Time Exemption) Act, 1942, it is enacted that the Governor may by Proclamation revoke any Proclamation previously issued under the said sec-tion 4 relating to the waiving or postponing of the payment of rent on any mining tenement which is pre-scribed and payable under the Mining Act, 1904-1937, and the exempting of the holder of any mining tenement from his obligation under the Mining Act, 1904-1937, to observe, comply with or perform any conditions re-lating to such mining tenement: Now, therefore I, Sir James Mitchell, Lieutenant-Governor as aforesaid, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do by this Proclamation revoke the Proclamations published in the *Government Gazettes* of the 5th day of March, 1943; 4th day of June, 1943, and the 3rd day of Sep-tember, 1943, in so far as the said Proclamations wived tember, 1943, in so far as the said Proclamations waived the payment of rent and/or exempted the holders of the mining tenements mentioned in the Schedule here-under from compliance with the labour covenants relating to such mining tenements.

WHEREAS by section 321 of the Health Act, 1911-1944, it is provided that the Governor may cause to be prepared Model By-laws for all or any of the purposes for which by-laws may be made by a local authority under any provisions of the said Act, and that a local authority may, of its own motion, by resolution, adopt the whole or any portion of such by-laws; and whereas Model By-laws were prepared in accordance with the provisions of the said section; and whereas such Model By-laws have been adopted for the district of Fremantle subject to such exceptions and amendments as have been made from time to time; and whereas the Municipal Council of the City of Fremantle is desirous of further amending the said Model By-laws: Now therefore, the Municipal Council of the City of Fremantle being a local health authority within the meaning of the said Act doth hereby amend its by-laws as follows:---

Substitute the following to stand in lieu of subclause (f) of section 26, Part 1 of the said model by-laws:---

(f) There shall be provided outside each such stable a receptacle for manure and such receptacle shall be constructed of brick or concrete. In the case of concrete being used then the mixture of such concrete shall be three parts of metal not larger than three-quarter inch screen, two parts of sharp sand and one part cement. Whether the receptacle be constructed of brick or concrete it shall be rendered internally to a hard smooth surface with cement mixture five-eighths of an inch thick, and the composition of such mixture shall be two parts sand to one part cement. The receptacle shall be provided with a tight fitting cover and shall be emptied at least once weekly.

The abovementioned Food and Drug Regulations, 1929, are amended by inserting therein after regulation 80, and before the paragraph headed "Repeal" a new regulation as follows:---

## 81.—Offence.

Where in relation to any food a standard is appointed by any provision contained in these regulations, a person shall not have in his possession for sale or shall not, in the course of or for the purposes of a sale, consign to any other person any quantity of such food which does not in all respects conform with the standard appointed by these regulations in relation to such quantity of food.

Provided that this regulation shall not apply so as to prohibit the offering for sale of any quantity of food, which does not in all respects conform with the standard appointed in relation thereto by these regulations when the Commissioner expressly sanctions the sale of such quantity of food upon and subject to any conditions which the Commissioner may think fit to impose, and such quantity of food is offered for sale strictly in compliance with such conditions.
