## PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency Sir James Mitchell,

WHEREAS by section 10 of the Native Administration Act, 1905-1941, it is provided that the Governor is empowered by Proclamation to declare any Crown lands to be reserves for Natives; and whereas it is deemed desirable that a reserve for Natives should be declared at Onslow: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby declare reserve No. 22675 (Onslow Lot 379) to be a reserve for Natives.

IN pursuance of the provisions of section 9 of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1940, I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby prohibit all persons from taking any fish whatsoever by the use of fishing nets in the waters of Irwin's Inlet or any portion thereof, including its tributaries, from the 1st day of January until the 30th day of April and from the 1st day of September until the 31st day of December (inclusive of the first and last days of each period)

in every year until further notice; and I do further prohibit, during the period commencing on 1st June and ending on the 31st August (both days inclusive) in each year, the use of any net in the aforesaid waters, excepting at the sand flat near the entrance, used or intended to be used by any method other than the methods known as "meshing," "setting," "bull-ringing" and "splashing."

The Proclamation relating to the closure of Irwin's Inlet published in the *Government Gazette* of the 30th July, 1943, is hereby revoked.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, on the 1st day of October, 1947, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1944.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 10 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1944, that it shall be obligatory for every employer to obtain from an incorporated insurance office approved by the Minister a policy of insurance for the full amount of the liability to pay compensation under this Act to all workers employed by him, but that if an employer proves to the satisfaction of the Minister that such employer has established a fund for insurance against such liability and has deposited at the Treasury securities charged with all payments to become due under such liability, the Governor may by Order in Council exempt such employer from the operation of the said section; and whereas Millars' Timber and Trading Company Limited, of St. George's House, Perth, being an employer within the meaning of the said section has, in accordance with the regulations, duly made application that it be exempted from the operation of the said section and has proved to the satisfaction of the Minister that it has established a fund for insurance against the liability to pay compensation under the said Act to all workers employed by it and has deposited at the Treasury securities (to wit, the sum of £5,000) charged with all payments to become due from the said Company under the said liability: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, doth hereby exempt the said Millars' Timber and Trading Company Limited, as such employer aforesaid, from the operation of section 10 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1944, for the period which shall end on the 15th day of September, 1949.

Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 302/47.

WHEREAS by the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Stormwater Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections and estimates in respect of the works herein-after mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

Metropolitan Water Supply Improvements.  
Perth Road District—Maylands.

Proposed 12-inch diameter water main in Dundas Road and Buller Street, complete with valves and all necessary apparatus, as shown in red on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A., No. 6986.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 10th day of October, 1947.
