### PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1950.

#### Prices Control Order No. 521.

Sawn W.A. Hardwood, Mouldings and Cartage.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

#### Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 521.

#### Revocation.

2. Insofar as its relates to timber, mouldings and cartage, Prices Control Order No. 491 is hereby revoked.

#### Definitions and Interpretations.

3. In this Order and the Schedules thereto, unless the contrary intention appears, the expression—

- (a) "W.A. hardwood" includes timber commonly known and referred to as jarrah, karri, wandoo, tuart, marri and W.A. blackbutt;
- (b) "Perth Metropolitan Area" means all that area comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office at Perth;
- (c) "Merchantable quality," "selected quality," "seasoned quality," means, in relation to any W.A. hardwood, that such timber conforms to the requirements and specifications for timber in A.S. 0.10 to A.S. 0.39 contained in "Grading Rules for Jarrah, Karri and Wandoo," *Forests Department of Western Australia Bulletin No. 56, 1948.*"

#### Maximum Prices for W.A. Hardwood and Mouldings.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any W.A. hardwood or mouldings specified in the First Schedule to this Order may be sold by retail in the Perth Metropolitan Area to be the price specified in that Schedule or computed in accordance therewith.

#### Maximum Rates for Sawing and Machining of W.A. Hardwood.

5. I fix and declare the maximum rate at which the service of sawing and machining of W.A. hardwood, specified in the Second Schedule to this Order, may be supplied by any person, to be the rate specified in that Schedule or computed in accordance therewith.

#### Maximum Rates for Cartage of W.A. Hardwood and Mouldings.

6. I fix and declare the maximum rate at which the service of cartage of W.A. hardwood and mouldings may be supplied by any retail seller of such W.A. hardwood or mouldings, to be the rate specified in the Third Schedule to this Order, or computed in accordance therewith.

#### Application for Maximum Prices.

7. A person shall not sell by retail any W.A. hardwood or mouldings, a maximum price for which is not fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, unless and until that person has made a written request to the Commissioner to fix the maximum price at which those goods may be sold, and the Commissioner has fixed the maximum price accordingly.

#### Discounts.

8. Notwithstanding anything contained in the provisions of this Order—

- (i) where any person sells any W.A. hardwood or mouldings, to any Government or semi-Government department, to any registered builder or contractor, or to any registered wood working manufacturer for use in their own activities, the maximum price fixed by the provisions of this Order for the sale of those goods, shall, in the case of any such sale, be reduced by 5 per centum;
- (ii) where payment for any W.A. hardwood or mouldings is made to the seller by any Government or semi-Government department or person specified in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph before the 25th day

of the month following the month in which the goods are purchased and delivered, the maximum price fixed by the provisions of this Order for the sale of those goods shall be reduced by a further 2½ per centum.

Delivery of Invoices or Dockets.

9. Any person who sells any W.A. hardwood or mouldings shall deliver to the purchaser thereof within 7 days of delivery of such specified goods to the purchaser an invoice or docket specifying the following particulars:—

- (a) His name and place of business.
- (b) The name and address of the purchaser.
- (c) The point of delivery to the purchaser.
- (d) The date of sale.
- (e) A full description of the goods, including quality, quantity, size and length, and whether the timber is rough sawn or dressed.

- (f) The price at which each quality, size and length is sold.
- (g) The total amount charged for such timber and/or mouldings.
- (h) The cartage charged.
- (i) The rates charged for sawing and machining.

Variation of Maximum Price or Rate by Notice.

10. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which W.A. hardwood or mouldings, or the maximum rate at which the service of cartage of W.A. hardwood or mouldings, or the service of sawing and machining W.A. hardwood, specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph, may be respectively sold or supplied by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price or rate as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.



## Joinery.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

## Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 522.

## Revocation.

2. Insofar as it relates to joinery, Prices Control Order No. 491 is hereby revoked.

## Definitions and Interpretations.

3. In this Order and the Schedules thereto, unless the contrary intention appears, the expression—

“joinery” means joinery of all kinds and descriptions;

“W.A. hardwood,” or “Western Australian hardwood” means timber commonly known and referred to as jarrah, karri, wandoo, tuart, marri and W.A. blackbutt;

“seasoned selected quality” means, in relation to Western Australian hardwood, that such timber conforms to the requirements and specifications for joinery stock “A.S.O. 10 to A.S.O. 36—1948,” contained in “Grading Rules for Jarrah, Karri and Wandoo,” *Forests Department of Western Australia Bulletin*, No. 56, 1948;

“Perth Metropolitan Area” means all that area comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office at Perth.

## Maximum Retail Prices—Joinery.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any article of joinery of the types or descriptions set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Order may be sold by any person by retail in the Perth Metropolitan Area, delivered free to any place within that area nominated by the purchaser, to be—

- (a) in respect of any unglazed article, the price specified in the third column of that Schedule according to the unit specified in the second column;
- (b) in respect of any glazed article, the price specified in the fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth or tenth column of the Schedule, according to the weight and description of glass contained in such article and the unit specified in the second column of the Schedule.

Provided that in respect of any article of joinery constructed from timber other than Western Australian hardwood, the maximum price fixed by the provisions of this Order may be increased by a sum calculated—

by multiplying the net superage of the timber contained in such article plus 10 per centum thereof, by the amount by which the maximum retail price per hundred super feet fixed under the Regulations for the particular size, length and type of timber used in such article exceeds the maximum retail price per hundred super feet fixed for the identical size, length and type of timber by the provisions of Prices Control Order No. 521.

## Application for Maximum Prices.

5. A person shall not sell by retail any article of joinery a maximum price for which is not fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, unless and until that person has made a written request to the Commissioner to fix the maximum price at which that joinery may be sold, and the Commissioner has fixed the maximum price accordingly.

## Delivery of Invoices or Dockets.

6. Any person who sells any article of joinery, shall deliver with that joinery an invoice or docket specifying the following particulars:—

- (a) His name and place of business.
- (b) The name and address of the purchaser of that joinery.
- (c) The date of sale of that joinery.
- (d) A full description of each article sold.
- (e) The price charged for each such article of joinery.

## Discounts.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in the provisions of this Order—

- (i) where any person sells any article of joinery to any Government or semi-Government department, to any registered builder or contractor, or to any registered wood working manufacturer for use in their own activities, the maximum price fixed by the provisions of this Order for the sale of those goods shall, in the case of any such sales, be reduced by 5 per centum;
- (ii) where payment for any article of joinery is made to the seller by any Government or semi-Government department or person specified in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph before the 25th day of the month following the month in which the goods are purchased and delivered, the maximum price fixed by the provisions of this Order for the sale of those goods shall be reduced by a further 2½ per centum.

## Variation of Maximum Price by Notice.

8. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any article of joinery specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
