AT a meeting of the Executive Council, held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, on the 18th February, 1955, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

Health Act, 1911-1954.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS in accordance with section 60 of the Health Act, 1911-1954, His Excellency the Governor has received details of a plan for the general installation of apparatus for the bacteriolytic treatment of sewage in the Municipality of Kalgoorlie by the Kalgoorlie Municipal Council and is satisfied that the scheme is formulated in accordance with the provisions of the Health Act, 1911-1954, and that the cost and provisions for repayment justify the undertaking and that the works if carried out in the manner designed will be of benefit to that portion of the district of the local authority which the works are designed to serve: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor by and with the advice of the Executive Council doth hereby order that the Kalgoorlie Municipal Council being the Local Health Authority for the Kalgoorlie Municipal Health District is hereby empowered to undertake the construction of the said works.
