WHEREAS it is enacted by section 25 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Act, 1910-1954, that the several articles mentioned in either the Fifth or the Ninth Schedule shall be deemed poisons within the meaning of the Act and that the Governor may by proclamation from time to time declare that any other article specified in such proclamation shall be deemed a poison within the meaning of the Act, provided also that the Governor, on the recommendation of the Council may by proclamation, *inter alia*, amend by adding to, taking away from, varying or modifying any of the items contained in the Ninth Schedule: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby—

- (a) declare to be poisons within the meaning of the Act—

Compounds of Fluorine, and

- (b) remove from the Ninth Schedule (G.G. 9/1/53) the items—

Hydrofluoric acid Hydrosilicofluoric acid, salts of these acids, and any other fluorine compounds.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section eleven of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1951, that every proclamation issued under section nine or ten of the Act may, *inter alia*, be revoked or varied at any time: Now, therefore, I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby revoke the proclamation dated the 3rd day of November, 1954, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 12th day of November, 1954, prohibiting the taking by any means whatsoever of the fish known as or called "Crayfish" in all those portions of Western Australian waters lying between Knobby Head on the Western Australian coastline at approximate latitude 29° 40' 00" South, and North Head (Jurien Bay) at approximate latitude 30° 14' South including the Western Australian waters of the adjacent islands of that area.

WHEREAS by section 13 of the Main Roads Act, 1930-1952, the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Commissioner, declare by proclamation that any road shall be a main road; and whereas the Commissioner has recommended that the road specified in the Schedule hereto be so declared: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, acting with and by the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do by this, my proclamation, declare that the road specified in the Schedule hereto shall be a main road within the meaning of the Main Roads Act, 1930-1952, and that the footpaths, if any, of such road be excluded from the main road.

Thence proceeding generally Northerly along road 1977 (North-West Coastal Highway), through Yanganooka to the Western corner of lot 18 of Alma Agricultural Area. Thence North-Easterly along road 1765 (North-West Coastal Highway) to the North-West corner of lot 18, thence generally North-North-Easterly along said road, crossing the railway to its Eastern side approximately one mile South of Ogilvie, thence through Government Reserve 2657 and loc. 9786 to the Eastern boundary of the railway reserve at Ogilvie siding, thence following the railway reserve to rejoin road 1765 (North-West Coastal Highway), thence Northwards along said road to the Northern boundary of location 9786, thence along the Western boundaries of location 4251, 4252 and 7314 and thence along the Eastern boundary of the railway reserve, passing Hutt siding, to road 8677 (North-West Coastal Highway), thence along said road to the Western extremity of location 8195, thence generally Northwards along the Western boundaries of location

8195, reserve 4267, locations 4256, 4257 and 4259, thence generally Northwards through locations 4539, 4540 and 7406, thence through Binnu Townsite, thence following the Eastern boundary of the railway generally to the South-Western corner of location 6603, thence generally Northwards along road 4271 (North-West Coastal Highway) to the North-West corner of location 4681, thence North-East and North along road 8301 (North-West Coastal Highway) to the North-East corner of location 5123 (Tank No. 4), thence North-North-West along road 6427 (North-West Coastal Highway) to the Northern boundary of location 5121, thence deviating through Galena Townsite and crossing Galena Bridge (Murchison River) to road 8570 (North-West Coastal Highway), thence generally North, North-West and North along said road to the 65 mile peg, thence approximately 1 mile North-North-West along a surveyed line, as delineated on Lands Department O.P. 2321, to the road district boundary, as shown on Plan M.R.D., W.A., 2535.
