AT a meeting of the Executive Council, held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 21st day of December, 1955, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued.

Health Act, 1911-1954.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.H.D. 166/54.

WHEREAS in accordance with section 60 of the Health Act, 1911-1954, His Excellency the Governor has received details of a plan for the general installation of apparatus for the bacteriolytic treatment of sewage in the townsite of Bruce Rock by the Bruce Rock Road Board and is satisfied that the scheme is formulated in accordance with the provisions of the Health Act, 1911-1954, and that the cost and provisions for repayment justify the undertaking, and that the works if carried out in the manner designed will be of benefit to that portion of the district of the local authority which the works are designed to serve: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby order that the Bruce Rock Road Board, being the local health authority for the Bruce Rock Health District, is hereby empowered to undertake the construction of the said works.

Manjimup Water Area.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by the Water Boards Act, 1904-1953, the Governor is empowered, by Order in Council, to alter or extend the boundaries of a Water Area; now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby extend the boundaries of the Manjimup Water Area in accordance with the Schedule hereto.

Water Boards Act, 1904-1953.

Manjimup Water Area.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 895/35.

WHEREAS by section 40 of the Water Boards Act, 1904-1953, it is enacted that subject to the provisions of the said Act a water board shall have power to construct water works for the purposes of the said Act; and whereas it is provided by section 41 of the said Act (as amended by the Water Boards Act Amendment Act, 1937) that the Governor may exempt reticulation works from the

operation of certain sections of the said Act; and whereas it is deemed expedient that the reticulation works referred to in the following schedule shall be exempt from the operations of the said sections of the said Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, and of all other powers in this behalf enabling him, doth hereby exempt from the operations of sections 41, 42, 43, 44 and 45 of the Water Boards Act, 1904-1953, the reticulation works included in the following schedule.

Morawa, Mingenew and Mullewa Road Districts.
Alteration of Common Boundary.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 1854/52.

HIS Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the provisions of the Road Districts Act, 1919-1954, doth hereby alter the boundaries of the Morawa, Mingenew and Mullewa Road Districts by—

- (a) transferring all that portion of Morawa Road District described in the Schedule A hereto to the Mullewa Road District to form portion of South Ward thereof;
- (b) transferring all that portion of the Mingenew Road District described in Schedule B hereto to the Mullewa Road District to form portion of the South Ward thereof.

Proposed Constitution as a Municipal District.

Extension of Time for Showing Cause against Proposal.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 524/55.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 8 of the Road Districts Act that the Governor may by Order in Council constitute the whole of a road district as a municipal district; and whereas notice of intention of His Excellency the Governor to constitute the whole of the South Perth Road District a municipal district under the name and title of "The Municipality of South Perth" was published in the *Government Gazettes* dated the 11th, 18th and 25th of November, 1955, and dated the 2nd day of December, 1955, by the Minister for Local Government; and whereas it is provided in section 9 of the said Act that if within one month or such extended time as the Governor directs after the first of such publications no sufficient cause is shown to the satisfaction of the Governor why the power proposed to be exercised should not be exercised the Governor may exercise the power; and whereas the period of one month specified in section 9 has now expired; and whereas it is desired to extend the period during which sufficient cause may be shown: Now, therefore, the Governor, acting pursuant to the powers conferred by section 9 of the Road Districts Act, doth hereby extend until Saturday, the 28th day of January, 1956, the period during which sufficient cause may be shown why the Governor should not constitute the whole of the South Perth Road District a Municipal District under the name and title of "The Municipality of South Perth."

BUSH FIRES ACT, 1954.

Suspension of Prohibited Burning Times.

Bush Fires Board,

Perth, 23rd December, 1955.

Corres. No. 271/38; Vol. 2.

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that
the Hon. Minister for Lands, acting under the
powers conferred by section 17, subsection (3) of
the Bush Fires Act, 1954, has approved of the sus-
pension of all declarations of prohibited burning
times made under section 17, subsection (1) of the
said Act so far as such declarations extend to any
land used for railway purposes in the road districts
and municipalities mentioned and for the periods
stated in the Schedule hereunder. Any burning
undertaken on railway land under the provisions
of this suspension shall be subject to the following
conditions:—

At least three men shall be constantly in attend-
ance at every fire until it has been completely
extinguished including all smouldering logs, timber,
disused sleepers, and other inflammable material.

Each man shall be provided with a heavy fire
rake and each three men with at least one knap-
sack spray with sufficient water for its operation.

The burning shall comply with all other relevant
provisions of the Bush Fires Act, 1954.
