WHEREAS by section 31 of the Land Act, 1933-1958, the Governor may, by Proclamation, and subject to such conditions as may be expressed therein, classify as of Class "A" any lands of the Crown reserved to Her Majesty for any of the purposes specified in the said section; and whereas it is deemed expedient that the reserve described in the schedule hereto should be classified as of Class "A": Now, therefore I, the Governor, with the advice of Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation classify as of Class "A" the reserve described hereunder.

WHEREAS by sections 223 and 225 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1958 (6 Edwardi, No. 32), it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the *Government Gazette*, to declare any land reserved, used, or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street or way, or any place, bridge, or thoroughfare, to be a public highway, and such land shall thereupon and thenceforth, from the date of such Proclamation, become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force; and whereas the City of Perth has requested that certain lands named and described in the Schedule hereunder which have been reserved for streets or ways within the City of Perth, be declared public highways: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation declare the said lands to be public highways, and such lands shall, from the date of this Proclamation, be absolutely dedicated to the public as highways within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

Child Welfare Act, 1947-1958.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 19 (2) (a) of the Child Welfare Act, 1947-1958, it is provided that the Governor may appoint such persons, male or female, as he may think fit, to be members of any particular Children's Court and may determine the respective seniorities of such members; and whereas by section 19 (1) (b) (ii) of the said Act the Governor may amend, vary or revoke any such appointment: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby revoke the appointment of Lionel Lewin Carter as a Member of the Children's Court, at Bunbury, and doth hereby appoint Reginald Monkhouse to be a Member of the Children's Court at Bunbury.

Forests Act, 1918-1954.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F.D. 957/48.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1954, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown Land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:—

- (a) the Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation;
- (b) after such proposal has been laid before Parliament, the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall, by Order in Council, revoke such dedication.

And whereas His Excellency the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposals dated the 2nd day of December, 1948, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown Lands as State Forest; and whereas after such proposals had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposals should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown

Lands as State Forest No. 30 by excising that portion of such State Forest as is described in the Schedule hereto.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by The Forests Act, 1918-1954, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown Land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner—

- (a) the Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation;
- (b) after such proposal has been laid before Parliament the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall, by Order in Council, revoke such dedication.

And whereas His Excellency the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposal dated the Tenth day of November, 1955, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest; and whereas after such proposal had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest No. 28 by excising that portion of such State Forest as is described in the Schedule hereto.

Water Boards Act, 1904-1954.

Bunbury Water Board—Proposed Loan of £9,000.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 317/53.

WHEREAS by the Water Boards Act, 1904-1954, a Water Board may, with the approval of the Governor, borrow money for the construction of works for the storage, distribution and supply of water: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby approves, under the provisions of section 113 of the Water Boards Act, 1904-1954, of the Bunbury Water Board borrowing the sum of nine thousand pounds (£9,000) from the Bank of New South Wales, and repayable with interest by thirty (30) equal half-yearly instalments over a period of fifteen (15) years with interest at the rate of five pounds ten shillings (£5 10s.) per annum for the purpose of financing the works referred to on Bunbury Water Board Plan No. 131 and approved by Order in Council dated the 25th day of February, 1959, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 6th day of March, 1959, subject to the said work being commenced not later than the first day of September, 1959.

Water Boards Act, 1904-1951, and the Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1912.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 260/35.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 6 of the Water Boards Act, 1904, that for every Water Area constituted under that Act, there shall be a Water Board constituted by the Governor by Order in Council; and whereas it is enacted by section 3 of the Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1912, that the Governor may revoke any Order in Council made before, or after, the commencement of the said lastmentioned Act, for the constitution of a Water Board under the Water Boards Act, 1904-1951, aforesaid, and dissolve the Water Board constituted pursuant to any Order so revoked; and whereas by an Order in Council dated the 5th day of February, 1919, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 14th day of February, 1919, the Governor, acting in exercise of the power conferred by section 6 of the Water Boards Act, constituted the Broome Road Board a Water Board to administer the Water Boards Act, 1904, in the Broome Water Area as constituted under that Act; and whereas it is now deemed desirable and expedient that the Water Board constituted pursuant to the said Order in Council should be dissolved: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the power conferred by section 3 of the Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1912, doth hereby as from and after the 1st day of July, 1959, revoke the said Order in Council and dissolve the said Broome Road Board as the Water Board constituted for the Broome Water Area pursuant to the said Order in Council.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 1st day of April, 1959, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1951.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

C.S.D. 445/58.

WHEREAS by section 5 of the Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1951, it is enacted, *inter alia*, that—

- (a) the municipal and road districts mentioned in the Second Schedule to the Act are, for the purposes of the Act, constituted fire districts, by the names as in the said Schedule stated;
- (b) the Governor may, by Order in Council, constitute the district of any other local authority a fire district; assign a name to any such district, and include the same in Part II, or Part III, or Part IV of the Second Schedule;
- (c) the Governor may, by Order in Council, excise from any fire district any specified portion thereof, and thereupon such portion shall, for the purposes of the Act, be no longer included in or be part of such district; and
- (d) subject as therein stated, the Governor may, by Order in Council, unite the district of or portions of the districts of two or more local authorities, or may unite the districts of any one or more local authorities with any portion or portions of another or others into one fire district, by such name as the Governor may think fit.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, doth hereby—

- (a) constitute the Gosnells Road District a fire district;

- (b) assign the name of Gosnells Fire District to that district and include the same in Part II of the Second Schedule to the Act;
- (c) excise from the Gosnells Fire District so constituted the portion thereof fully described in the Appendix to this Proclamation; and
- (d) unite the Gosnells Fire District with the municipal and road districts comprising the Metropolitan Fire District and mentioned in Parts I and II of the Second Schedule to the Act, which districts as so united shall be known as the metropolitan fire district.

Appendix.

All the land contained within the boundaries of the Gosnells Fire District with the exception of that portion of the district bounded by lines starting at the southernmost corner of Canning Location 246, a point on the Gosnells Road District boundary and extending south-easterly in prolongation of the south-western boundary of that location to the south-eastern side of William Street; thence south-westerly along that side to the north-eastern side of Tooting Street; thence south-easterly along that side to a point situate in prolongation north-easterly of the north-western boundary of lot 321 of location 7 as shown on Lands Titles Office Diagram 2896; thence south-westerly to and along that boundary and the north-western boundaries of lots 322 to 326 inclusive to the north-eastern side of Brixton Street; thence south-easterly along that side to the north-western boundary of location 243; thence south-westerly along that boundary to the westernmost corner of that location; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of that location and onwards to the north-western boundary of location 11; thence south-westerly along that boundary to the westernmost corner of lot 30 of location 11 as shown on Lands Titles Office Diagram 18609; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of that lot to its southernmost corner; thence south-easterly across Wanaping Road to the westernmost corner of lot 105 of location 11 as shown on Lands Titles Office Plan 3380; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern side of Park Road to the northern alignment of Kenwick Road; thence generally easterly along that side to a point situate in prolongation north-easterly of the south-eastern side of Lalor Road; thence south-westerly to and along that side to the eastern side of Belmont Road; thence southerly along that side to a point situate in prolongation north-easterly of the south-eastern side of Austin Avenue; thence generally south-westerly to and along that side across the south-western railway reserve to the north-eastern side of Albany Highway a point on the south-east boundary of location 12; thence south-westerly along that boundary to the easternmost corner of lot 21 of location 12, as shown on Lands and Surveys Department Diagram 64146; thence generally north-westerly along the north-eastern boundaries of that lot and the south-western severances of lots 22 to 28 inclusive, as shown on Diagram 64146 aforesaid, to the south-eastern side of Osmond Street; thence north-westerly across that street to the intersection of its north-western side and the south-western side of road No. 11337, as shown on Lands and Surveys Department Original Plan 7264; thence generally north-westerly along that side and the south-western side of Rupert Street (road No. 6247) to the north-eastern boundary of a drain reserve along the north-western boundary of location 10; thence north-easterly along that boundary and its prolongation 1 chain 89 and four-tenths links to a survey peg shown on Plan 7264 aforesaid; thence north-westerly across the Spearwood-Midland Junction controlled access road to the intersection of the north-west boundary of location 9 and the south-western side of Wimbledon Street; thence generally north-westerly along that side to the southern side of Albany Highway, as shown

on Lands and Surveys Department Plan Original 7265; thence westerly along that side to the eastern alignment of Highbury Crescent; thence southerly, generally south-westerly, and north-westerly along that side to the south-eastern side of Nicholson Road; thence generally south-westerly along that side to the right bank of the Canning River; thence generally north-westerly along that bank to the north-western boundary of location 6, a point on the Gosnells Road District boundary; thence generally north-easterly along that boundary to the starting point. (Public Plan 1D/20, S.E.)

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. No. 3578/58.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1958, it is, *inter alia*, made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be granted in fee simple to any person (as defined in the said section) subject to the condition that the person shall not lease or mortgage the whole or any part of the land without the consent of the Governor and subject to such other conditions and limitations as the Governor shall deem necessary to ensure that the land is used for the purpose for which the land is reserved as aforesaid; and whereas it is deemed expedient that reserve No. 22135 (Port Hedland Lot 33) should, subject as aforesaid, be granted in fee simple to the Roman Catholic Bishop of Geraldton to be held in trust for the purpose of a "Church Site (Roman Catholic)": Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserve shall be granted in fee simple to the aforesaid body to be held in trust for the aforesaid purpose, subject to the condition that the land shall not be leased or mortgaged in whole or in part without the consent of the Governor.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corr. No. 4224/57.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1958, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, road board, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order, and with power of sub-leasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that reserve 24890 should vest in and be held by the Perth Road Board in trust for "Kindergarten and Children's Playground": Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserve shall vest in and be held by the Perth Road Board in trust for Kindergarten and Children's Playground with power to the said Perth Road Board, subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said reserve for any term not exceeding 21 years.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1958, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, road board, or other person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order; and whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:—

Corr. No. 1211/26.—That reserve No. 19323 should vest in and be held by the Mandurah Road Board in trust for the purpose of "River Improvements and Camping."

(This supersedes the previous Order in Council dated the 6th April, 1955.)

Corr. No. 12/49.—That reserve No. 25217 should vest in and be held by the Mt. Marshall Road Board in trust for the purpose of a "Sheep Dip Site."

Angove Creek Catchment Area.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 579/58

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 9 of the Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1957, that the Governor may, by Order in Council, constitute a Catchment Area: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby constitute the Angove Creek Catchment Area as defined in the attached Schedule, and to assign the name of "Angove Creek Catchment Area" thereto.

This Order in Council shall take effect on the 1st day of April, 1959.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 255/20.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 8 of the Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1957, that the Governor may, by Order in Council, alter or extend a Country Water Area: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby extend the Albany Country Water Area as defined in the Schedule hereunder.

This Order in Council shall take effect on the 1st day of April, 1959.

Schedule.

Extension of the Albany Country Water Area.

(a) All that portion of land comprised within 450 links on either side of a pipeline already constructed and now laid down in on or over that land and being the land delineated and coloured red on Department of Lands and Surveys Miscellaneous Plan 236 and on Department of Public Works Plan P.W.D., W.A., 36644.

(b) All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from a point situate 115 chains north of the 27-mile peg on the former northern boundary of Plantagenet Location 416 as shown on Department of Lands and Surveys Original Plan Plantagenet 133 and extending south about 310 chains to a northern boundary of location 3777; thence westerly, south-westerly, southerly and again westerly along boundaries of that location to its westernmost north-western corner; thence westerly and northerly along boundaries of part of location 3643 and onwards to and along eastern boundaries of locations 6452, 6451, 6450, 6447, the southernmost eastern boundary of location 6446, the eastern side of a one chain road and onwards to a point within location 6446 aforesaid, situate west of the starting point; and thence east through locations 6446, 2773, 5293, 5295 and 5296 to the starting point. Being the land delineated and shown bordered blue on Miscellaneous Plan 236 and on Plan P.W.D., W.A., 36644.
