WHEREAS by sections 223 and 225 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1958 (6 Edwardi, No. 32), it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the *Government Gazette*, to declare any land reserved, used, or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street or way, or any place, bridge, or thoroughfare, to be a public highway, and such land shall thereupon and thenceforth, from the date of such Proclamation, become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force; and whereas the City of Perth has requested that certain land named and described in the Schedule hereunder which has been reserved for streets or way within the City of Perth, be declared public highways: Now therefore I, the said Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation declare the said land to be public highways, and such land shall, from the date of this Proclamation, be absolutely dedicated to the public as highways within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1958, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, road board, or other person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order; and whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:—

Corr. No. 14123/08.—That reserve No. 12276 should vest in and be held by the Dandaragan Road Board in trust for the purpose of Water, Camping and Gravel.

(This Order in Council supersedes that appearing on page 2878 of *Government Gazette* (No. 89) of 20th November, 1959.)

Corr. No. 3177/48.—That reserve No. 24438 should vest in and be held by The Fauna Protection Advisory Committee of Western Australia in trust for the purpose of Protection of Flora and Fauna.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that beforementioned reserves shall vest in and be held by the above-mentioned bodies in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F.D. 1098/57.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1954, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:—

- (a) The Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation.
- (b) After such proposal has been laid before Parliament the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall, by Order in Council revoke such dedication.

And whereas His Excellency the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposal dated the 16th day of October, 1957, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest; and whereas after such proposal had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest No. 4 by excising that portion of such State Forest as is described in the Schedule hereto.

(1) Berths: A prolongation of the line of the face of North Wharf from a point marked "A" on attached plan F.H.T. 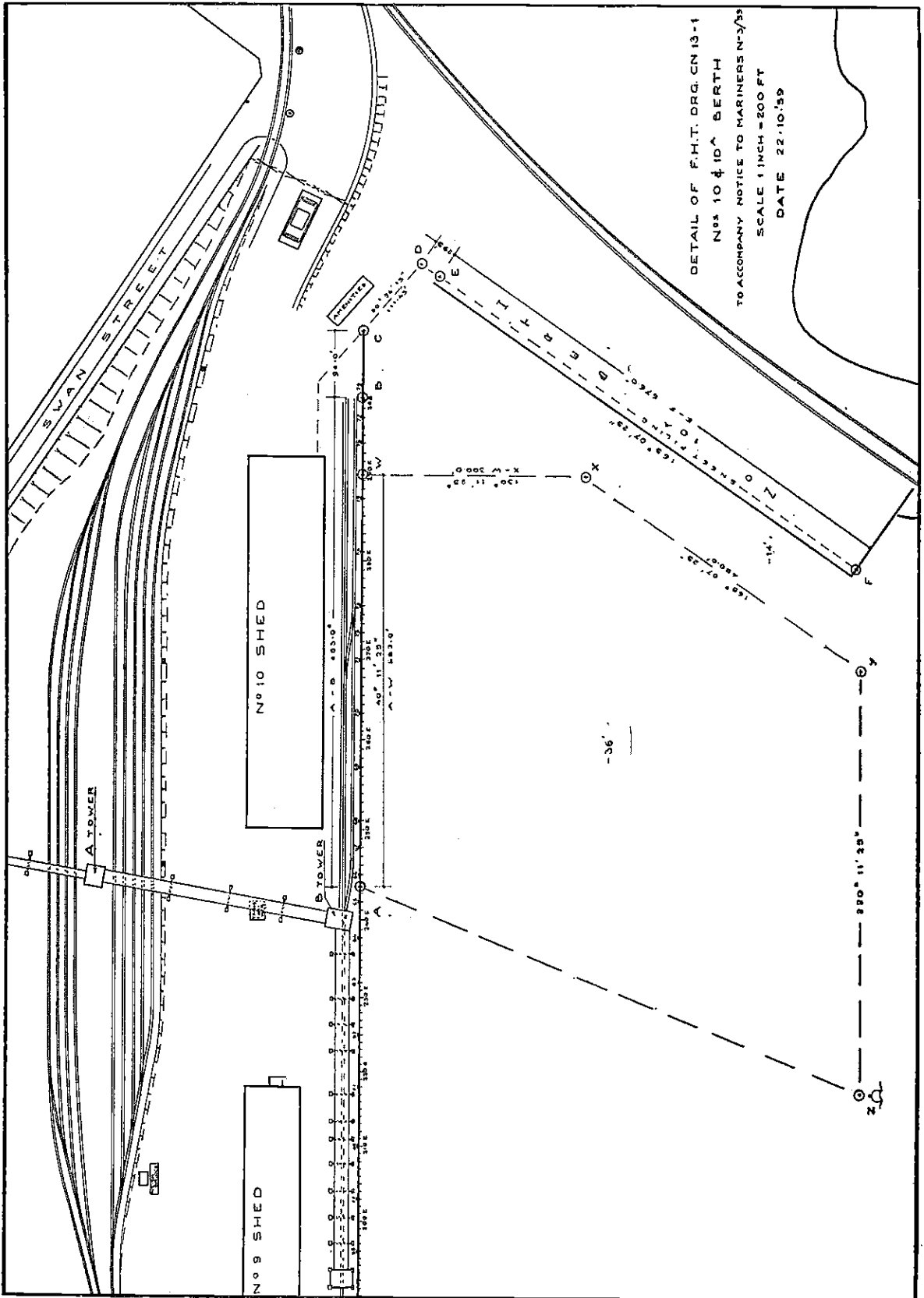

Town Planning Scheme No. 4A.

1. Area.—This scheme shall apply to the land contained within the blue border of the scheme plans numbered Plan No. 1 and Plan No. 3. The said land is hereinafter referred to as the area.

2. General Objects.—The general objects of the scheme are to improve and develop the area to the best possible advantage and to secure suitable provision for new roads and to enable the land in the area to be subdivided.

3. Acquisition of Land.—The land in the area of the scheme shall be resumed or otherwise acquired for the purposes of the scheme.

4. Re-survey of Area.—The area shall be re-surveyed according to the design shown on Plan No. 3.

5. Works to be Carried Out.—

- (a) Construction and drainage of roads.
- (b) Levelling and grading of land where necessary.

6. Re-allocation of Lots.—The lots created by the re-survey of the area will be apportioned among the owners of land in the area as nearly as may be proportionately to the area of land previously owned by each individual owner. Each individual owner will be offered a block or blocks of land as nearly as may be in the same position as the land acquired from him and where possible having the same amenities of view, corner position and the like. The offer will be made subject to the owner releasing the Board from all claims for compensation in respect of the acquisition of his land, and subject to the payment by him of his proportion of the costs of the scheme.

The remaining lots, if any, will be treated as surplus lots.

7. Surplus Lots.—All surplus lots shall be sold by the Board.

8. Method of Sale of Surplus Lots.—The Board may sell the surplus lots, either by public auction, tender, or private contract, as a whole or in separate lots, upon such terms and conditions as the Board shall think fit. In the event of a sale by private contract, the price shall not be less than the price recommended by the Chief Valuer of the Taxation Department of Western Australia, unless after submitting the land for sale by public auction or by tender that price has not been obtained.

9. Costs of Scheme.—The scheme shall be debited with—

- (a) the administration costs of the scheme;
- (b) the costs of the survey of the area;
- (c) the costs of construction and drainage of the internal roads;
- (d) the half costs of construction and drainage of unmade perimeter roads;
- (e) the costs of levelling and grading of land where necessary;
- (f) the interest on money borrowed (if any) by the Board for the purposes of the scheme;
- (g) all compensation payable to owners who do not accept the offer mentioned in paragraph 6 hereof and all costs and expenses of determining and settling the compensation payable;
- (h) the costs of the transfers of the new lots to the owners pursuant to paragraph 6 hereof;
- (i) all other costs and expenses incidental to the scheme.

10. Apportionment of Costs.—The costs of the scheme shall be divided equally between all new residential lots in the area. Upon a transfer of a new lot to an owner, his proportion of the net costs of the scheme shall be paid by him.

11. Claims for Compensation.—In the event of any claims for compensation not having been settled at the time when the Board is ready to transfer lots pursuant to this scheme the Board may estimate the amount of compensation payable and the costs relating thereto and debit the scheme with the net amount so estimated. In the event of the Board doing so the difference between the estimate and the actual compensation and costs payable shall be received or paid by the Board as the case may be.

12. Encumbrances on Title.—In the event of any land in the area being subject to a registered mortgage charge or lease or to a caveat to protect the interest of the purchaser, mortgagee, chargee or lessee, the Board shall not transfer a new lot to the owner unless subject to similar encumbrances or with the consent of all persons entitled to the benefit of the encumbrances.

13. Minimum Value of Building.—No person shall construct or permit or authorise the construction of any building (other than an outbuilding) within the area of a value of less than £2,500.

COTTESLOE TOWN PLANNING SCHEME No. 2.

(Cottesloe Shopping Centre Development Plan.)

Part I.—General.

1.—Title and Commencement.

This scheme may be cited as the Cottesloe Town Planning Scheme No. 2 (Cottesloe Shopping Centre Development Plan) and shall take effect on the 27th day of November, 1959, and remain in force for a period of two years thereafter unless before the expiration of such period it shall be extended, amplified or revoked by a subsequent scheme duly approved by the Minister.

2.—Area of Scheme.

The area to which this scheme applies is that portion of the Municipality of Cottesloe bounded by the centre lines of Jarrad Street, Railway Street, Forrest Street and Stirling Highway.

3.—Arrangement of Scheme.

This scheme comprises the following Parts and Documents:—

- Part I.—General.
- Part II.—Land Use Zoning.
- Part III.—Implementation.
- Plan No. 3.—Zoning Map.

4.—Purposes of the Scheme.

The purposes of this scheme are:—

- (a) To amplify and vary the Cottesloe Town Planning Scheme gazetted on 11th November, 1949, as subsequently amended and amplified in accordance with relevant notices gazetted on 21st September, 1951, and 29th March, 1956.
- (b) To facilitate the replanning and re-development of the area shown hatched blue on Plan No. 3 and described in Part II of this Scheme as a Business Development Zone.
- (c) To provide for the carrying out of such works and other things as may be necessary to implement this scheme.

5.—Variation of Previous Scheme.

After the date on which this scheme takes effect and so long as it remains in force in pursuance of clause 1 hereof, the Cottesloe Town Planning Scheme gazetted on 11th November, 1949, as subsequently amended and amplified, shall be read in conjunction with this scheme and where inconsistent this scheme shall prevail.

6.—Interpretation.

“Service industry” means a light industry carried on in premises having a retail shop front and in which goods may be manufactured only for sale on the premises, or a shop being used as a depot for receiving goods to be serviced by the industry.

“Service station” means land used for the purpose of fueling motor vehicles and the carrying out of routine servicing, such as oiling, greasing, cleaning, etc., and the sale of accessories and parts that does not include the uses of spray painting, panel beating and major repairs unless a special permit has been granted by the responsible authority.

7.—Application of Scheme.

After the date on which this scheme takes effect and so long as it remains in force in pursuance of clause 1 hereof, material alterations to existing works or buildings, the erection or construction of new works and buildings, and the use or adaptation for use of land, buildings or works otherwise than in accordance with the provisions and tenor of this scheme are prohibited.

Provided that subject to the provisions of clause 18 hereof buildings and works and the use thereof lawfully existing at the date of gazettal of approval of the scheme may be maintained and continued.

8.—Responsible Authority.

The Council of the Municipality of Cottesloe shall be responsible for enforcing and carrying into effect the provisions of this scheme and is hereinafter referred to as the responsible authority.

9.—Classification of Zones.

In this scheme the area is divided into the several zones described in the first column hereunder and defined by the colours indicated in the

second column and in the notation on Plan No. 3. In case of doubt the definition on Plan No. 3 shall prevail.

Zone.	Colour on Plan No. 3.
Hotel Zone	Coloured red-brown with a blue dot.
Service Station Zone	Coloured blue-green with a white dot.
Central Business Zone	Coloured blue.
Business Development Zone	Edged and hatched blue.
Service Industrial Zone	Edged blue and hatched purple.
Public Uses Zone	Edged red.

Part II.—Land Use Zoning.

10.—Hotel Zone.

Within the Hotel Zone no land or buildings shall be used and no buildings or works shall be erected or constructed except for the purposes of a licensed hotel or for such purposes including car parking as are in the opinion of the responsible authority ancillary to a licensed hotel.

11.—Service Station Zone.

Within the Service Station Zone no land or buildings shall be used and no buildings or works shall be erected or constructed except for the purposes of a service station as herein defined or for such purposes including car parking as are in the opinion of the responsible authority ancillary to a service station.

12.—Central Business Zone.

Within the Central Business Zone no land or buildings shall be used and no buildings or works shall be erected or constructed except for such purposes other than hotels, service stations, fire stations and police stations as are permitted in the Business Zone in the Cottesloe Town Planning Scheme gazetted on 11th November, 1949, as subsequently amended and amplified.

13.—Business Development Zone.

Within the Business Development Zone no land or buildings shall be used and no buildings or works shall be erected or constructed except for the purposes permitted in clause 12 above relating to the Central Business Zone or for the purpose of a shopping centre including pedestrian malls, small shops, department stores, landscape gardens, car parking and service ways or such other purposes as are in the opinion of the responsible authority ancillary to the development of a comprehensive shopping centre.

Provided that the responsible authority may require as a condition of granting consent under clause 16 hereof to a scheme of development of a shopping centre the provision of three square feet of suitably laid out and surfaced car parking space for every one square foot of commercial floor space.

14.—Service Industrial Zone.

Within the Service Industrial Zone no land or buildings shall be used and no buildings or works shall be erected or constructed except for the purpose of a service industry as herein defined or for such purposes including car parking as are in the opinion of the responsible authority ancillary to a service industry.

15.—Public Uses Zone.

Within the Public Uses Zone no land or buildings shall be used and no buildings or works shall be erected or constructed except for the purposes of a public authority which purposes will not in the opinion of the responsible authority detract from the amenity of the locality or be inconsistent with the purposes and tenor of this scheme.

Part III.—Implementation.

16.—Consents.

After the date on which this scheme comes into effect and so long as it remains in force in pursuance of clause 1 hereof no person shall, except with the prior consent in writing of the responsible authority, cause land or buildings to be used for purposes other than those lawfully existing at the date of gazettal of approval of this scheme or erect or construct or materially alter any buildings or works in the area to which this scheme applies. Application for such consent shall be made to the responsible authority in writing accompanied by such plans or particulars as the responsible authority may require.

Provided that where application is required to be made to the responsible authority in accordance with any by-law or regulation other than this scheme for consent or approval to the erection or construction of buildings or works such application shall be deemed to be an application for consent under this clause.

17.—Closure of Streets and Redisposition of Public Utility Services.

For the purposes of this scheme the responsible authority is authorised—

- (a) to close any public street, except the Stirling Highway, or right-of-way or any parts thereof which may in the opinion of the responsible authority be necessary for implementation of this scheme;
- (b) to arrange for the redisposition of public utility services including water, sewerage, gas, and electricity, in so far as may be necessary for implementation of this scheme.

18.—Business Development Zone.

To secure the objects of this scheme, and in particular to facilitate the development of a comprehensive shopping centre within the area to which the scheme applies, the responsible authority may acquire any land within the Business Development Zone and transfer by way of sale, sale on terms or lease, all or any part thereof to any person or company for the purpose of enabling the development of such land in accordance with a scheme of development to which the responsible authority has given consent in accordance with clause 16 hereof.

Provided that the responsible authority shall on the sale or lease of such land fix the selling price or rental or other payments under a lease or agreement at such amount as will reimburse the full costs involved, including the cost of redisposition or provision of public utility services or such proportion of the full costs as the responsible authority may determine in relation to part of the land the subject of sale or lease.

19.—Advisory Committee.

The responsible authority may institute an advisory committee comprising such representatives of the Cottesloe Municipal Council, the Cottesloe Chamber of Commerce and the Cottesloe Ratepayers' Association as the responsible authority may determine, and may invite an officer of the Town Planning Department to assist the advisory committee.
