FISHERIES ACT, 1905-1960.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, under the provisions of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1960, has been pleased to make the regulations set out in the Schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

Regulations.

1. The regulations made under the Fisheries Act, 1905, published in the *Government Gazette* on the 6th May, 1938, and amended from time to time thereafter, are, in these regulations, referred to as the principal regulations.
2. Regulation 14A of the principal regulations is amended—
 - (a) by substituting for sub-regulation (2) the following sub-regulation:—
 - (2) No person shall bring ashore from any boat any crayfish tail or any severed part of any crayfish, unless such tail was removed from the carapace of the crayfish or the crayfish was cut or otherwise processed in a registered export establishment;
 - (b) by substituting for sub-regulation (3) the following sub-regulation:—
 - (3) A person shall not have in his possession, sell or offer or expose for sale, or give or consign any crayfish tail of a less length than 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches, measured along the dorsal midline of the terga of the segments from the anterior margin of the first abdominal segment to the posterior margin of the telson, and of a less weight than five ounces;
 - (c) by revoking sub-regulation (4).
3. The principal regulations are amended by substituting for regulation 19 the following regulation:—
 19. Every label attached to any bag, basket, box or other receptacle containing fish shall be in form Q in the appendix to these regulations and shall be a standard No. 6 manilla tag, and every label shall be securely affixed by nail or strong cord to each bag, basket, box or other receptacle.

4. The principal regulations are amended by adding after regulation 19 the following regulation:—

19A. Any fish delivered, consigned, carried or transported shall be in prescribed bags or in baskets, boxes or other receptacles, and the total weight of fish in any bag, basket, box or other receptacle shall not exceed 100 pounds.

5. The Appendix to the principal regulations is amended by adding after form "P" the following form "Q":—
