WHEREAS by section 11 of the Native Welfare Act, 1904-1954 it is provided that the Governor is empowered by Proclamation to declare any Crown lands to be a Reserve for Natives; and whereas it is deemed desirable that a Reserve for

Natives should be declared at Gascoyne Junction: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby declare all that portion of land containing approximately 25 acres, known as Gascoyne Junction Lot 14 to be a Reserve for Natives. (Reserve No. 25868.)

WHEREAS the enactment contained in section 74 of the Constitution Act, 1889, whereby the appointment of all public officers under the Government of the State is vested in the Governor in Council, does not apply to minor appointments which, by Act of Legislature or by Order in Council, may be vested in the heads of Departments or other officers or persons within the State; and whereas it is desirable that the appointment of persons as employees of the Forests Department and its branches at a daily or weekly rate of wages should be vested in Cyril James Edwards or any person appointed to temporarily act in place of such officer: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby vests in Cyril James Edwards and any person appointed to temporarily act in place of such officer the appointment of persons as employees of the Forests Department and its branches at a daily or weekly rate of wages.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserves shall vest in and be held by the abovementioned bodies in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

WHEREAS it is enacted under section 9 of the Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1960, that the Governor may, by Order in Council, constitute a Catchment Area: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, by and with the consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby constitute the Wicherina Catchment Area as defined in the Schedule hereunder, and assign the name of "Wicherina Catchment Area" thereto.

location; thence generally southerly and westerly along boundaries of that location to the north-eastern corner of location 7358; thence westerly and southerly along boundaries of that location to the north-eastern corner of location 9906; thence westerly and northerly along boundaries of that location to its northern corner and onwards to the south-eastern boundary of location 7976; thence south-westerly and westerly along boundaries of that location to the south-eastern corner of location 3191; thence westerly along the southern boundary of that location to the south-eastern corner of location 3557; thence northerly along the eastern boundaries of that location and location 1046 to the southernmost south-western corner of location 2252; thence generally northerly along western boundaries of that location to the south-western corner of location 3192 aforesaid, and thence northerly along the western boundary of that location to the starting point, as shown bordered blue on plan P.W.D., W.A. 38718.
