ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. No. 7315/06.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1960, it is, *inter alia*, made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be granted in fee simple to any person (as defined in the said section) subject to the condition that the person shall not lease or mortgage the whole or any part of the land without the consent of the Governor and subject to such other conditions and limitations as the Governor shall deem necessary to ensure that the land is used for the purpose for which the land is reserved as aforesaid; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 11335 (Meekatharra Lots 182 and 183) should, subject as aforesaid, be granted in fee simple to the Roman Catholic Bishop of Geraldton to be held in trust for the purpose of a "Church Site (Roman Catholic)": Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the before-mentioned reserve shall be granted in fee simple to the Roman Catholic Bishop of Geraldton to be held in trust for the purpose of a "Church Site (Roman Catholic)," subject to the condition that the land shall not be leased or mortgaged in whole or in part without the consent of the Governor.
