WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (2) of section 4 of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1961, that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Minister and the Board, from time to time, and at any time, by Proclamation declare any portion or portions of the State to be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of that Act; and whereas the Minister and the Board have recommended that the lands described in the schedule hereunder be declared totalisator agency regions for those purposes: Now, therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare that as from and including the 25th day of June, 1962, the several lands described in the schedule hereunder shall each be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1961.

Schedule.

- I. The whole of the land contained in the municipal district of the town of Bunbury.
- II. The whole of the land contained in the townsite of Brunswick Junction, as defined in the *Government Gazette* published on the 14th October, 1938.

Water Boards Act, 1904-1954.
Harvey Water Board—Proposed Loan £3,500.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 662/46.

WHEREAS by the Water Boards Act, 1904-1954, a Water Board may, with the approval of the

Governor, borrow money for the construction of works for the storage, distribution and supply of water: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby approves, under the provisions of section 113 of the Water Boards Act, 1904-1954, of the Harvey Water Board borrowing the sum of three thousand five hundred pounds (£3,500), for a period of fifteen years, payable by half-yearly instalments, at the rate of five pounds ten shillings (£5 10s.) per centum per annum, for the installation of automatic boost pump and extension of mains within the Harvey Water Area, subject to the said works being commenced not later than the 1st day of January, 1963.
